

Conditions of Entry

1. To be run under Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2017 – which can be downloaded from the Pony Club website [here](#), please read them and don't hesitate to ask if you have any questions.
2. Age as at 1st January 2017, tadpole competitors may shoot if they are 8 on day.
3. Judge's decision is final, competitors must be current Pony Club or Pentathlon GB members.
4. **Shooting:**
Please remain silent outside the shooting hall, please use the other areas as much as possible, to ensure the competitors shooting are able to hear the safety instructions and concentrate on their competitive shoot.
In accordance with the law on Air Pistols: **No person under the age of 18 is allowed to carry a gun**, anyone found doing so will be eliminated from the competition. Guns must not be unboxed until authorised by the steward. Guns must be kept hidden and locked away after use – please lock them in your car boot after shooting, please do not leave in shooting hall, as the organisers cannot supervise them. Please ensure all shooters have been coached.
5. **Swimming: Only 1 Team Coach per swimmer allowed at the shallow end** and please sit / stand back from the pool edge to enable the lane judges to walk back and forwards to judge the swims accurately and safely. Please ensure all competitors are safe and happy swimming lengths before entry.
6. **Photography: No photography or mobile phones used in the swimming pool or adjacent area please.** Otherwise, entry is deemed agreement that photographs may be taken

Legal Liability Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
