

## Conditions of Entry

1. To be run under Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2018 – which can be downloaded from the Pony Club website [here](#), please read them and don't hesitate to ask if you have any questions.
2. Age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018
3. Judge's decision is final, competitors must be current Pony Club or Pentathlon GB members.
4. Shooting:  
Please remain silent outside the shooting hall, please use the other areas as much as possible, to ensure the competitors shooting are able to hear the safety instructions and concentrate on their competitive shoot.  
**In accordance with the law on Air Pistols: No person under the age of 18 is allowed to carry a gun, anyone found doing so will be eliminated from the competition.** Guns must not be unboxed until authorised by the steward. Guns must be kept hidden and locked away after use – please lock them in your car boot after shooting, please do not leave in shooting hall, as the organisers cannot supervise them.
5. Swimming: Only 1 Team Coach per swimmer allowed at the shallow end and please sit / stand back from the pool edge to enable the lane judges to walk back and forwards to judge the swims accurately and safely.
6. Photography: **No photography in the swimming pool or adjacent area please.**  
Otherwise, entry is deemed agreement that photographs may be taken.

**Legal Liability** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

**Health And Safety** The organiser of this Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

**Insurance** Non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club Insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Belvoir Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
