

Rules

1. To be run under [Pony Club Dressage Rules 2018](#).
2. Open to Pony Club and Non Pony Club members.
3. Age as of 1st January 2018.
4. Competitors in Classes 1 to 3 may have the test commanded.
5. Competitors in Classes 1 & 2 may be ridden in any normal riding bit.
6. Horses or Ponies must be 5 years old or over.
7. No stallions unless by prior arrangement with the organiser.
8. Hats. It is mandatory for all competitors to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted with the chin straps fastened and adjusted so as to prevent movement of the hat in the event of a fall. The hat must be manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed in the [Pony Club Hat Rule 2018](#). Hat checks will be carried out. All hats must be tagged with an **aquamarine** Pony Club, British Eventing (BE) or British Riding Club (BRC) hat tag; this can be done on the day.
9. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class if there are insufficient entries.
10. Any objections must be made within 15 minutes of completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00.

Legal Liability Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Health And Safety The organiser of this Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event.
