

## Rules

**Please can team managers ensure that all their competitors are aware of the competition rules and format.**

1. To be run under the [Pony Club Show Jumping Rules](#).
2. Open to all Pony Club members (25 years & under). Age as of 1st January 2017.
3. The same rider may compete twice in a team on a different horse/pony (except class 2).
4. Hats. It is mandatory for all competitors to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted with the chin straps fastened and adjusted so as to prevent movement of the hat in the event of a fall. The hat must be manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed in the [Pony Club Show Jumping Rules](#). Hat checks will be carried out. All hats must be tagged with either a white Pony Club hat tag or red British Eventing hat tag; this can be done on the day.
5. No competitor or representative will enter the Judges Box at ANY TIME during the day.
6. Any queries should be addressed to the organiser.
7. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition. Rider to remember to produce spur card if wearing spurs or to wear B test felt.
8. Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended at any time, or left tied to the outside of lorries or trailers. Please could you ensure that you clear up any droppings left by your horse / pony.

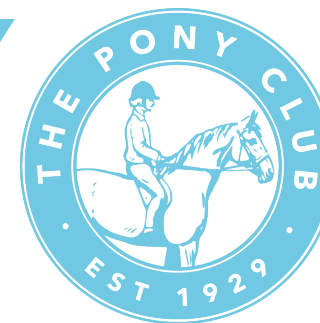

1.10m in the first round with two fences at 1.15m

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**Ring 2**      **Start time: 9.00am**

**CLASS 3**      **Open: 80cm\***

Teams of 4 riders

**CLASS 4**      **Open: 90cm\***

Teams of 4 riders

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**Ring 3**      **Start time: 9.00am**

Riders in this ring may **NOT** compete in any other ring.

**CLASS 5**      **10 Years & under: 60cm**

Teams of 4 riders

**CLASS 6**      **Novice: 75cm**

Teams of 4 riders

Combinations cannot have competed in any Area Competition at **ANY** level (Open, Intermediate, Novice or Grassroots) or BSJA competitions.

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**\*If there are more than 15 Teams in any class the Organiser reserves the right to run a single phase competition on the day.**

### Format & Scoring

**Classes 1, 3 - 6:** Teams of four riders with the best three scores to count. Two rounds will be jumped with the second round being over a shortened course and timed. Riders will jump as a team in both rounds. If single phase, the 2nd half of the round will be against the clock.

**Class 2 (Hickstead Qualifier):** The class will be judged over one round with a jump-off against the clock if there is a tie for the qualifying places. (See 'Additional information for Hickstead Qualifier' for further information.)

### Fees

Entry fee is **£48 per team**. Please make cheques payable to 'The Belvoir Hunt Branch of the Pony Club'

**No team will be allowed to compete unless entry fee has been paid prior to the start of the competition and the team has been declared on the day.**

### Team Declaration

Team members must be declared in jumping order half an hour prior to the commencement of classes.

No substitutions allowed following the commencement of classes.

### Dress and Saddlery

All competitors will have dress and saddlery checked by a steward. Please ensure stirrups are of the correct size to suit the rider's boots with at least a 7mm (¼") clearance on either side of the boot. Body Protectors are optional, air jackets if worn, must be worn in combination with a body protector.

### Course Walk & Arena Party

The course will be available for walking prior to the start of each class and a course walk will feature mid-way through the classes

Each branch is responsible for putting up fences when their own team are jumping. Please can team managers ensure that all competitors are aware of this.

Teams must be present at each collecting ring on time to jump, or they will forfeit their place.

### Trophies, Prizes & Rosettes

Challenge cups will be presented to the winning teams of Classes 1- 4  
Prizes in kind will be awarded to the winning teams of Classes 5 & 6  
Rosettes will be awarded to teams placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> and all individual double clears.
