- 1. To be run under the cross country section of the <u>Pony Club Eventing Rules 2017</u>. Please ensure you are familiar with them.
- 2. Open to all Pony Club and **NON** Pony Club members.
- 3. Age as of 1st January 2017.
- 4. Entries are limited and taken in order of receipt.
- 5. Horses or ponies must be 5 years old or over.
- 6. Stallions are not permitted at this event.
- 7. Hats It is mandatory for all competitors to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted with the chin straps fastened. It must bear the CE mark and a quality symbol .See Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2017 for full details. Hat checks will be carried out. All hats must be tagged with either a white Pony Club hat tag or red British Eventing hat tag; this can be done on the day.
- 8. No horse or pony may compete more than once in any class. No horse or pony may compete more than three times in total during the day.
- 9. Body protectors are compulsory. Air jackets if worn must be in combination with an approved body protector.
- 10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class if there are insufficient entries.
- 11. Any objections must be made within 15 minutes of completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00.
