

Rules

1. To be run under the cross country section of the [Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2018](#). Please ensure you are familiar with them.
2. Open to all Pony Club and **NON** Pony Club members.
3. Age as of 1st January 2018.
4. Entries are limited and taken in order of receipt.
5. Horses or ponies **must** be 5 years old or over.
6. Stallions are not permitted at this event.
7. Hats. It is mandatory for all competitors to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted with the chin straps fastened and adjusted so as to prevent movement of the hat in the event of a fall. The hat must be manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed in the [Pony Club Hat Rule 2018](#). Hat checks will be carried out. All hats must be tagged with an **aquamarine** Pony Club, British Eventing (BE) or British Riding Club (BRC) hat tag; this can be done on the day.
8. No horse or pony may compete more than once in any class. No horse or pony may compete more than three times in total during the day.
9. Body protectors are compulsory. Air jackets if worn must be in combination with an approved body protector.
10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class if there are insufficient entries.
11. Any objections must be made within 15 minutes of completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00.

Legal Liability Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Health And Safety The organiser of this Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

<u>CLASS 2</u>	40cm approx Can be led or accompanied. Class will be split for prize giving.	Individual
<u>CLASS 3</u>	50cm approx	Individual
<u>CLASS 4</u>	60cm approx	Individual

Rounds will be timed and places will be decided by proximity to the optimum time in all classes in the case of equality of points. The optimum time will be appropriate for the riders at this level.

Entries and Withdrawals

Dress & Tack Code

Competitors may wear either cross country colours or tweed jacket and a tie or stock. All competitors must wear jodhpur / riding boots and stirrups should be of the correct size to suit the rider's boots. They must have 7mm (¼") clearance on either side of the boot. It is compulsory to wear a body protector and all hats must be PC tagged - see Rules section below. **Grass reins are not permitted but Daisy reins may be used for courses of up to 50cm.**

Prize Giving

Prizes will be awarded to 1st place and rosettes to 6th place. Rosettes to Best Belvoir in each class.

Prize winners should be correctly dressed in riding clothes for the prize giving. Please note it is discourteous for prize winners not to attend the prize giving. If you genuinely cannot wait please arrange for someone else to collect your rosette or make arrangements with the Secretary. Failure to do this will result in forfeiture of prize.

Course Inspection and Venue

The course will be open for inspection on Saturday 22nd September 2018 after 9.30am.

There will also be a 10 minute course walk between classes.
