

## MAIN CAMP KIT LIST 2017

**All items must be clearly labelled** – yours is not the only PC tie at Camp!!

This list is a guide and is not exhaustive or prescriptive. Please do not bring superfluous items.

Towels	Jodpurs, 3/4 pairs, one pair must be beige	Salt lick
Toiletries	Riding Jacket & Gloves	Hard feed and bucket
Plastic mug, bowl, plate	2/3 numnahs	Waterproof riding coat
Knife, fork, spoon	Saddle complete	Hairnets
Waterproof trousers	Bridle, martingale (if worn) etc.	Plaiting equipment optional
Torch and extra batteries	Whip(s) if carried	Fly spray, hoof oil
Money, small amount	Riding Hat (no fixed peak for XC)	
Pencil and notebook	Body Protector (level 3 2009 for XC)	
Mobile phone with alarm	Tack cleaning kit	
T-shirts and underwear	Headcollar and rope	
Jeans/trousers	Rugs (weather/stable stain prevention etc)	
Trainers/muckers/Wellingtons	Pony's boots/bandages if worn	
Branch sweatshirt and jumpers	Muck sack/wheelbarrow	
Swimming Kit (for swim or shower)	Mucking out tools	
PC tie, badge,	Stable bedding	
Branch polo shirts\white shirts with collars	Haynet - small holes preferably
