1. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
2. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Cottesmore Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.
3. **Photography-** By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer and give permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club activities to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of The Pony Club and/or official sponsors of The Pony Club. I understand that The Pony Club will select photographs/ footage for publication with care and respect for those shown.
4. Competition to be run under the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2018
5. **Hats** of all competitors must conform to Pony Club regulations - details at - http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/Hat_Rule_2018_FINAL.pdf and must be tagged with the new joint British Eventing, Riding Clubs and Pony Club aquamarine tag. Hats must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Hat tagging at Secretary's tent.
6. Horses and Ponies must be 5 years old or over.
7. Tests may be commanded.
8. The decision of the judge is final and any objection must be made to the Organiser within 15 minutes of the results with a deposit of £20, refundable if upheld.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition.
10. Age as at January 1st 2018
11. Body Protector – All competitors must wear a body protector that meets BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) - details at - http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/Body_Protector_Rule_2018.pdf
12. The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition
13. Anyone eliminated in any phase of the Event may still take part in the remaining phases with the Organizer's permission.
14. **DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED AS THIS IS AWORKING FARM.**
15. The practice fences may only be jumped prior to starting the XC and SJ phases.

HEALTH AND SAFETY
