WHICH SHOULD HAVE ELASTIC RATHER THAN TIES

CLASS 1 BEGINNERS (PC LEVEL 1)

Riders aged 10 and under on 1st January 2012. Combination of Pony & Rider not to have represented their Branch in Open, Intermediate or Novice Eventing or to have competed at a BE Event.

ENTER EARLY AS CLASS FILLS UP VERY QUICKLY

Dressage: Pony Club D Level Dressage Test (Walk & Trot)
Showjumping: 60 cm approx.
Cross Country: 60 cm max **OVER SHORTENED COURSE**

CLASS 2 BEGINNERS PLUS (PC LEVEL 1)

Combination of Horse/Pony & Rider not to have represented their Branch in Open, Intermediate or Novice Eventing or to have competed at a BE Event.

ENTER EARLY AS CLASS FILLS UP VERY QUICKLY

Dressage: PC Introductory Dressage Test 2007
Showjumping: 65cm approx.
Cross Country: 60cm max **OVER LONGER COURSE**

CLASS 3 MINI (PC LEVEL 2)

Combination of Horse/Pony & Rider not to have represented their Branch in Open, Intermediate or Novice Eventing or to have competed at a BE Event.

Highest Placed OBHN member to be awarded "THE NASH MINI CHALLENGE CUP" (if in first six).

ENTER EARLY AS CLASS FILLS UP VERY QUICKLY **

Dressage: PC Introductory Dressage Test 2007
Showjumping: 80cm approx.
Cross Country: 75cm max

CLASS 4 NOVICE (PC LEVEL 3)

Combination of Horse and Rider not to have represented their Branch in Open Area Eventing or to have completed a BE Event Pre-Novice and above.

Highest placed OBHN member aged 12 & under on 1st January 2012 (if in the first six) to be awarded "THE ATLANTA CHALLENGE CUP". Highest placed OBHN member aged 13 & over on 1st January 2012 (if in the first six) to be awarded "THE DOUBLE D CHALLENGE CUP".

Dressage: PC Novice Eventing Test 2006
Showjumping: 95cm approx.
Cross Country: 90cm approx.

CLASS 4

Open to three or four members from any one Pony Club or Riding Club Branch. 1 member to have competed in Class 1 or 2, 2 members to have competed in Class 23 and 1 member to have competed in Class 4. Individual scores will count as Team scores and the best THREE scores will count for the Team.

The NAMES & NUMBERS of the Team Riders must be declared to the Secretary IN WRITING before the start of the class by the Branch/Club representative on the enclosed form.

RULES & CONDITIONS

1. The decision of the Judges and Stewards is final.
2. The trials will be judged in accordance with PC Eventing Rules 2012.
3. Neither OBH N Pony Club nor the landowner nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

The organisers of this Event have taken reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and competitors must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.

4. No horse/pony under 5 years may compete.
5. No horse/pony may compete more than once in any phase.
6. Correct riding attire and hat (PAS 015:1998, EN 1384:1996, BS EN 1384:1997 - with BSI Kitemark, AS/NZS 3838 1988/2003 - with SAI Global symbol, Snell E2001- with official Snell label & number) must be worn at all times when mounted and will be checked. **BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE WORN FOR THE CROSS COUNTRY PHASE. MEDICAL ARMBANDS MUST BE WORN BY ALL COMPETITORS.**
7. Spurs may only be worn by Pony Club members who have obtained the written consent of their District Commissioner.
8. No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date unless a veterinary or medical certificate is produced before 9.00 a.m. on the day of the Trials and given to the Secretary - a £5 admin fee will be charged. **IN THE EVENT OF CANCELLATION OF THE COMPETITION, ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED LESS £5 PER ENTRY TO BE RETAINED BY OBH N TO COVER COSTS.**
9. For withdrawals before the closing date, entry fees will be refunded less a £2 administration fee.
10. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or vary or cancel the event without explanation.
11. Objections to be lodged at the Secretary's caravan in writing accompanied by a deposit of £10 within 30 minutes. If sustained the deposit will be refunded.
12. No stopwatches allowed on the cross country phase.
13. Any Competitor having 3 refusals at the same fence during the Cross Country Phase must leave the course immediately.
14. **ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.**
