



South Durham Hunt Pony Club

Team and Individual Show Jumping Competition

Including qualifying places for Dengie Debut and Dengie Winter league.

Held at Seagold Centurion, Birtley Lane, Hunwick, Co Durham DL15 0SG

Sunday 11th November starting at 10am, open to non-pony club members and adults.

Numbers for each class will be limited so get your entries in early to avoid disappointment. Entries will close once classes are full – this may therefore be before the closing date.

Classes 1, 2 and 3 can be entered as a Team of three or four persons, with the three best scores counting. You may also enter as an individual. Team members will automatically be entered into the individual competition at no extra cost.

Team and individual classes

Class 1 50cm

Class 2 60cm

Class 3 70cm

Individual classes

Class 4 80cm (to include Dengie Debut qualifier)

Class 5 90cm (to include Dengie Winter League qualifier)

Team rosettes to 4th place.

Individual rosettes to 6th place.

Entries fees are £48 (team of 4) £36 (team of 3) or £12 for an individual entry.

Closing date for receipt of entries is Friday 2nd November. Approximate class start times will be posted on the main South Durham website <http://www.sdhpc.org.uk> on Friday 9th November. **No entries on the day.**

RULES

- * Competitors who jump clear will go straight into a shortened course against the clock.
- * No lead rein entries accepted.
- * Hats must be worn at all times. PC Members must abide by PC hat rule (11) and hats need to be tagged.
- * No nickel bits or irons to be used.
- * Ponies/horses must be tacked up properly and riders smartly dressed for all classes.
- * We reserve the right to refuse entries from those we feel are over qualified/or entered the wrong class.
- * Judges decisions are final; any objections must be accompanied by a deposit of £10 that will be refunded if the objection is upheld within 30 minutes of the class finishing.
- * No skipping out on the car park. Please make sure all litter and droppings are removed including the car park and warm up arena.
- * No dogs

All competitors and owners of horses/ponies take part in this event at their own risk. It is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the organisers or landowners with respect to loss, damage, accident, injury or illness however caused. If you are not a member of the pony club, you are strongly recommended to have your own insurance cover for at least 3rd party liability.
