

Conditions of entry

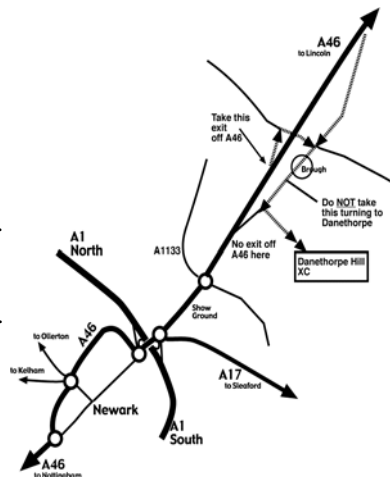
1. The event will be run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2010.
2. Objections must be logged in writing to the organiser with £10.00 deposit.
3. There will be no refund for withdrawal of entry after the closing date.
4. Only the designated practice fences may be jumped.
5. Competitors must be correctly dressed and wear gloves for the Dressage Phase.
6. An effective Body Protector must be worn for the Cross Country Phase.
7. All participants must wear a Pony Club tagged hat whilst mounted. We will provide a tagging service for hats not already tagged. The BE tag does NOT avoid the need for the Pony Club Tag. To qualify for Pony Club tagging, hats must bear the CE mark AND a quality symbol, either the BSI kitemark, the SAI Global symbol or the official Snell label with number. The CE number on its own is insufficient to ensure consistent standard of manufacture. The PAS 015-:1998 and the Snell E2001 meet the higher impact criteria and therefore give more protection. See the Pony Club Rule book 2010 for full details.
8. Ages to be taken as on 1st January 2010.
9. Medical Armbands must be worn for the Cross Country Phase.
10. Pony Club competitors who have not passed the full Pony Club B Test may only wear spurs if they have the written permission of their District Commissioner. I.E signed PC membership card. Please bring this in case of inspection.
11. Stop watches are not allowed for the Cross Country Phase.
12. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible neither the organiser of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club nor any agent employee representative of the bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, land, cars or their contents and accessories or any other person or properties whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

Health and Safety

The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable Precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone Present. For these measure to effective everyone present Must take responsible care to prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the officials and stewards.
