Class 4 Jumps 60/65cm

Class 5 Jumps 70/75cm

Class 6 Jumps 80/85cm

Class 7 Jumps 90/95cm

Class 8 Jumps 1.00/1.05m

Outdoor Arena starting at 9am.

Track will remain the same for all 3 classes

Class 1 Clear Round Jumps 35/40cm can be assisted or led

Class 2 Jumps 40/45cm can be assisted but not led

Class 3 Jumps 50/55cm

- $\succ$  Team and individual rosettes to  $6^{th}$  place in each class/section. Prizes for winning team and individual.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. The event will be run under the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2023. This can be downloaded from <a href="www.pcuk.org">www.pcuk.org</a> or ordered from Amazon. Tack and dress must conform.
- 2. This competition requires annual equine flu boosters. See PC 2023 equine flu policy
- 3. No outside assistance is allowed except in classes 1 & 2.
- 4. Entry fees will only be refunded for withdrawals made **before** the closing date.
- 5. Entries will be limited and taken on a first come basis.
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to amend the times of classes or cancel classes according to entries. If by close of entries there are less than 4 teams in a class, the class will run as an individual competition only. If less than 6 individual entries the class will not run
- 7. Hats must be pink tagged according to the 2023 PC hat standard.

- 8. Clear up droppings from around where you park and in the warm up. Do not feed hay on the outside of trailers/boxes. Horses left unattended must be secured inside their transport.
- 9. A maximum of 8 competitors will be allowed in the warm up
- 10. No refunds for withdrawals made after the closing date
- 11. NO DOGS

#### **Legal Liability**
