RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 **THE DISTRICT COMMISSIONER OR SECRETARY MUST SIGN ALL PONY CLUB ENTRIES** to indicate that the competitor is competent to compete in the selected class. If not signed, entries will not be accepted.
- 2 Each horse/pony may compete in one class plus the pairs
- 3 **When collecting numbers from the Secretary, all competitors must bring their Skull Caps for inspection. If a competitor is wearing a "Point 2 Air Jacket", please bring your own number bib and print off your own number and register with the secretary.**
- 4 **All tack and dress must conform in all respects to the Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2018. NB This includes DC spurs permission. Skull caps must be of current standard (PAS 015:1998 and must carry the official BSI Kite Mark) and must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted.** All competitors must wear body protectors whilst riding the cross country course and Medical Armbands are advised if Riders are not accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 5 All competitors **must** report to the Tack Steward who will be in the warm up area out on the course prior to proceeding to the start.
- 6 **All competitors who have a fall must report to the Secretary** and competitors failing to finish the course must report back to the starter.
- 7 Approximate times will be available on the Strathearn Pony Club website - <http://branches.pcuuk.org/strathearn/news-2/> on Friday 4th May, at the Start's vehicle at the course from 1400hrs on Saturday 5th May or by **telephoning Mrs Jackie Innes Tel: 01577 850362/07787 525139 between 7 - 9pm on Friday 4th May.**
- 8 The course will be open for walking from 1400hrs on **Saturday 5th May.**
- 9 Should weather conditions necessitate cancelling the event; £5.00 per entry will be retained by the Committee to cover administrative costs. If there is any doubt about the weather conditions, please telephone Mrs Jane Cepok Tel: 07860457119 on **Thursday 3th May** after 1830hrs or Mrs Jackie Innes Tel: 07787 525139.
- 10 Entry fees will only be refunded if Mrs Innes is notified of withdrawal **BEFORE** the closing date or after the closing date on production of a vet's certificate.
- 11 **Adults, or children who are not members of the Pony Club, must make their own insurance arrangements.**
- 12 HC entries will be accepted if places allow.
- 13 Younger Pony Club competitors may compete in classes for older children subject to the approval of their DC.
- 14 Stopwatches, or timing devices of any kind, are not permitted.
- 15 Refreshments will be available throughout the event.
- 16 Riders who choose the Woof Wear Exo BodyCage must lodge a key with the event secretary when they collect their number. If a rider chooses to wear an air vest, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall it must be fully deflated or removed before continuing. Air Jackets must not be worn under any item of clothing, and number bibs should be fitted loosely or with elastic fastenings over the air jacket.
