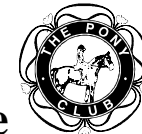
**Classes will be judged in accordance with PC Horse Trials Rule Book 2011**

#### **With the following amendments:**

1. A Horse or Pony may enter one class only. However, ponies may be shared in Class 1 or ridden by a different rider in one other class.
2. All Dressage Tests may be commanded.
3. **Outside assistance** of any kind is strictly forbidden in Classes 2, 3 and 4 and will lead to disqualification.
4. Competitors may continue to next fence after 3 refusals in either jumping phase, with permission from the relevant judge and provided they do not obstruct other competitors.
5. **Number Cloths:** No deposit, but a charge of £10.00 will be made to any competitor who loses or fails to return a number cloth.
