Applications are now open for this year's Junior Camp. held at
Rodbaston Equestrian, Penkridge, ST19 5PH
Monday 27th – Wednesday 29th July 2026

We have the full use of the Rodbaston facilities, including the indoor arenas, outdoor arenas and mini xc course.

Residential Camp is open to members over 7 and under 12 years of age
Day Camp is available to members under 12 years of age

The key aims of camp are:-

- Enjoy your pony and improve your **riding** and **horsemanship**
- Develop your **teamworking** skills
- Learn best practice in **caring** for your pony
- Learn new skills and try different disciplines
- Share tasks, **knowledge** and learning with others
- And, most importantly... have **fun, support** each other and build long lasting **friendships!**

Sleeping:

Campers will sleep in the Hayloft - bring camp beds and sleeping bags

Stabling:

Ponies will be stabled between the main 8-block atrium and an adjacent block of competition-standard temporary stables.

A Day Bed of Shavings and Hay will be provided, please bring Haylage and further shavings if required.

Catering:

Food will be prepared by our team of parent helpers and served in the hayloft.

Contributions to the camp larder (cakes / biscuits) will be gratefully received for providing snacks to keep campers going during the day.

Camp Fees:
Day Camp - £140.00
Residential Camp - £260.00

Riding Groups:

Each ride group will consist of a maximum of 6 members and benefit from a combination of ridden and on-foot learning, setting goals for the camp, with their assigned Coach.

Lead Rein:

We hope to provide all Lead-rein riders with a senior member leader for the duration of camp to allow parents the opportunity to observe and assist in the general running of camp

Ponies/Horses:

Must have in-date vaccinations in line with Pony Club guidelines and passports will be required to be submitted prior camp for checking. They should be 5 years of age, (4 years with DC approval) in good fitness and health and well shod (if relevant)

Activities:

In the evenings there will be a movie night on the Monday night, and a games night on the Tuesday night.

Camp Mandate:

We cannot run camp without an Army of helpers and we therefore ask that if at all possible each family provides at least one half-day of adult assistance during camp.

Please indicate on the application as to the possible days you would be available to help and we will co-ordinate a rota.

Technology !:

As there will be young campers present, please ensure that *all* campers leave phones and other technology at home for the duration of camp.

Day Campers:

Ponies and riders are brought to camp each day and go home for dinner, returning after breakfast.

There may be the option for a temporary stable to be hired for parents of under 7 years old who would find it easier to stable the pony at camp for the 3 days. The cost per stable is £105 (including hay and a day-bed of shavings) and the pony will be cared for by the parent in the day and the stable manager during the evenings/early morning.
