

# Prix Caprilli

## Riding Test No11

1989 (revised 2024)

This test is to be judged under the Area 12 Prix Caprilli rules, as a test of the riding ability NOT as a dressage Test.

The test may be commanded or ridden from memory  
The test must be ridden in a standard 40m x 20m dressage arena

### Jumping

After the second refusal at a jump the rider goes on to the next movement. Marks will be at the judges discretion.

A whip may be carried but must not exceed 75cm. If a jumping whip is carried, it must be held in the hand by the handle at the top. The whip must be padded as the pony club jumping rules.

Spurs may not be worn.

Fences should not be less than 10ft and not more than 12ft long including stand.

#### Fence 1

Single Rail 0.45m high, at right angles to a line running through X and 2m from the F and H corners. The centre of the rail should be 5m from X

#### Fence 2

Parallel rails 0.60m high, 0.60m wide should stand at right angles to a line running through X and 7m from the K and M corners. The centre of the rail nearest X should be 5m from X

### Test Penalties

Approx time 4.5 minutes

Errors of course

1st time 2 points

2nd time 5 points

3rd time 10 points

4th time Elimination

Use of voice

Each occasion 2 points

Martingale 5 points

Scale of marks

10 excellent    4 insufficient

9 very good    3 fairly bad

8 good        2 bad

7 fairly good    1 very bad

6 satisfactory

5 sufficient

All trot should be executed rising unless otherwise stated
