Windsor 17th & 18th May 2025

Must be aged 14 on 1st Jan 2025
Team of 3, 1 competitor from each area (7,9 & 12)
(either 1 boy & 2 girls or 2 boys & 1 girl)
Competitors may only compete at Windsor ONCE
Current Pony Club member who has completed at least 3 rallies in the past year
Proven tetrathlon and triathlon record
Nominated by Branch Tetrathlon Manager to Area Tetrathlon Manager
Recommendation required from Area Tetrathlon manager to Central Manager
Must be prepared to loan horse to Northern Irish competitor
Team selected by Central England Coordinator after discussions with the Area Tetrathlon Managers from Areas 7, 9 & 12

Stepping Stones at Tetrathlon Championships – Offchurch Bury - 8th & 9th August 2025

Teams and Individuals: 11yrs and under on 1st Jan 2025
Actively competing at Mini or Tadpole level
Current Pony Club member who has completed at least 3 rallies in the past year
Two teams of 5 competitors, any mix of boys and girls
Track record of tetrathlon and triathlon
Must be confidently jumping 80cm Arena Eventing / Cross Country
Results from Area Tetrathlon Mini 80cm class will be noted
Results from Mini International 80cm class will be noted
Competitors can be selected more than once
Nominated by Branch Tetrathlon Manager to Area Tetrathlon Manager
Recommendation required from Area Tetrathlon manager to Central Manager
Team selected by Central England Coordinator after discussions with the Area Tetrathlon Managers from Areas 7, 9 & 12

Mini International – Oxtalls Farm – 28th & 29th June 2025

Teams and Individuals: 11yrs and under on 1st Jan 2025
Individuals only: 12 yrs on 1st Jan 2025
Current Pony Club member who has completed at least 3 rallies in the past year
Teams of five competitors, any mix of boys and girls
Preferable to have a record of triathlon and tetrathlon

Must be confidently jumping 80cm Cross Country
Competitors can be selected more than once
Nominated by Branch Tetrathlon Manager to Area Tetrathlon Manager
Recommendation required from Area Tetrathlon manager to Central Manager
Team selected by Central England Coordinator after discussions with the Area
Tetrathlon Managers from Areas 7, 9 & 12

Junior International – Moreton Morrell – 31st May & 1st June 2025

Team & Individuals: 14 yrs and under on 1st Jan 2025
Individuals only: 15 yrs on 1st Jan 2025
Current Pony Club member who has completed at least 3 rallies in the past year
Teams of 5 competitors, either all girls or all boys
Proven tetrathlon and triathlon record
Must be confidently jumping 90cm Cross Country
Competitors can be selected more than once
Nominated by Branch Tetrathlon Manager to Area Tetrathlon Manager
Recommendation required from Area Tetrathlon manager to Central Manager
Team selected by Central England Coordinator after discussions with the Area
Tetrathlon Managers from Areas 7, 9 & 12

Senior International – Houston, Renfrewshire – (1st?) 2nd & 3rd August 2025

Teams & Individuals: 24yrs and under on 1st Jan 2025
Current Pony Club member who has completed at least 3 rallies in the past year
unless at university or in full time employment
Teams of 5 competitors, either all girls or all boys
Proven tetrathlon and triathlon record
Nominated by branch manager
Must be confidently jumping 100cm Cross Country
Competitors can be selected more than once
Nominated by Branch Tetrathlon Manager to Area Tetrathlon Manager
Recommendation required from Area Tetrathlon manager to Central Manager
Team selected by Central England Coordinator after discussions with the Area
Tetrathlon Managers from Areas 7, 9 & 12
