## **RULES OF THE SHOW**

### **Health & Safety**

Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

#### **Legal Liability**

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

All competitors and handlers must agree to abide by the following rules of the show. Entries will be strictly limited and will only be accepted when accompanied by the correct fee. Late entries will be taken if classes are not full and will be charged at £3.00 extra per class. Telephone entries will not be accepted.

Please do not come to the show if you are unwell

- 1. All classes are run under Pony Club rules
- 2. No pony may enter more than 3 jumping classes
- 3. Ponies must be up to date with all relevant vaccinations, passports must be brought to the secretary on collection of numbers as random checks will be made.
- Pony Club approved headgear must be worn at all times by anyone mounted. Spotchecks may be made
- 5. The judge's decision is final
- 6. Competitors must wear correct riding wear
- No Money will be refunded in the case of cancelled entries except on production of a current doctor's or vet's certificate
- 8. In case of cancellation of the show, entry fees will be refunded in full on receipt of a SAE minus a £5 admin fee
- 9. No whips or spurs in gymkhana events
- 10. Practice jumps must be jumped from the correct side ( with the red flag on the right hand side). Failure to do so may result in elimination
- 11. Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times, please clean up after your dog.
- 12.Lead reins must be attached to the noseband and should at no time pass through or be attached to the bit rings
- 13. This show has been organised solely by parents and volunteers who have given up their time to ensure you have an enjoyable time. We would ask that you show respect and courtesy at all times.

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2024. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.05m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventer's Challenge from 50cm through to 90cm.

Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  place; Showing & Eventers Challenge  $1^{st} - 4^{th}$  place. Qualification does not pass down the line.
