This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from 12th -15th September 2024

The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.0m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventer's Challenge from 50cm through to 90cm.

Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping 1st – 3rd place; Showing & Eventers Challenge 1st – 4th place. Qualification does not pass down the line.

Registration must be completed within 1 month of qualification (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to horse and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status, please check the website www.sunshinetour.co.uk for Terms & Conditions.


Ring 1 Show Jumping Ring
SJ Entry Fee: £12:00

Start 9am prompt


Individual times will be given to competitors in class 1 in this arena all other classes will have approximate start time. All classes will be run as single phase.

 **Class 1- Tiny Cross Poles**


Riders can be assisted in the round. Open to those aged 10 years and under. All unplaced double clears will receive a rosette. Any combination entering class 1 may only enter class 2.

 **Class 2 - PC40**

Rider any age. Combination not to have been placed 1st at any competition 70cm or higher.

 **Class 3 - PC60**


Rider any age. Jumps 50-60cm approx.

 **Class 4 - PC70**


Rider any age. Jumps 70cm approx.

Class 5 - Pairs Relay (PC70) Entry Fee: £15

Riders any age. Jumps to be 70cm approx. Table A4. If the first rider is eliminated, they can pass the whip to the second rider in the changeover box and the second rider may then finish the first riders course and go on to complete their own round.

 **Class 6 - PC80**

Rider any age. Jumps 80cm approx.

 **Class 7 - PC90**

Rider any age. Jumps 90cm approx.

 **Class 8 My First Rally Pony**

Under 13.2hh. Riders 10yrs & Under. This class will be judged on the pony's suitability for all Pony Club activities. Rosettes to all

Please state age of rider & height of horse on the entry form

 **Class 9 Pony Club Pony**

Riders not to have reached their 25th birthday on 1st January 2024.

Horses 153cm or under. This will be judged on manners, versatility and conformation. You will be required to jump. Lead rein is not permitted

Please state age of rider and height of horse on the entry form

 **Class 10 Handy Pony**

Open to anyone on horses or ponies 153cm or under. This is a series of obstacles and challenges to see who has the most handy pony!!

In-hand or ridden.

☀️ Class 12 Coloured Class
Section A Ridden: Odd Coloured and Piebald & Skewbald – ridden horse or pony
Section B In-hand: Odd Coloured and Piebald & Skewbald – In hand horse or pony

☀️ Class 13 Veterans
Horse or Ponies must be 20yrs or over. In-hand or Ridden.
Please state your horses or ponies age on the entry form

☀️ Class 14 Most Handsome Gelding & Prettiest Mare
Section A: Most Handsome Gelding – can be in hand or ridden
Section B: Prettiest Mare – can be in hand or ridden
Please state which section on the entry form

Ring 4 Clear Round

£5 pay on the day

Start 8.45am approx

A rosette for all clear rounds. Height of fences will be relevant to the show jumping class taking place

Class 15 Horse and Hound Start approx. 1.00pm

Riders on ponies jump a 60cm course of show jumps and are judged on faults and style. Runners with dogs on leads, jump the same course but are judged on speed. The results are combined to give an overall winning team.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

1. **Health & Safety** - Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
2. **Legal Liability** - Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
3. **Rules** - This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024 and BS where stated. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules.
4. **Horse Vaccinations** - No horse/pony may take part unless it has a Record of Vaccination against equine influenza which complies with the requirements set out in the Pony Club Vaccination Rules 2024
5. **Dress & Tack Safety** - All riding hats must conform to the Pony Club Health & Safety Rulebook 2024 and must be tagged with a pink tag. Hats to be worn at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened and no jewellery is permitted as per the Pony Club rules: <https://pcuk.org/officials/health-and-safety/dress-and-tack/>
6. **Objections** - The judge's decision is **final in all matters**. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the conditions or competitions, as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 not later than 20 minutes after the incident, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
7. **Refusal of Entries** - The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
8. **Refunds** - Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition.
9. **Event Cancellation** - In the event of cancellation, notification will be posted on the Wokingham PC website. Monies will be refunded less £5.00 per entry administration fee.
10. **Horse Age** - Horses or ponies must be 4 years or over on the day of the show.
11. The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by 26th May 2024 to wokinghampcshows@gmail.com

On the day:

- **Numbers:** No numbers will be issued at the venue. Please use your own bib, bridle, or numnah numbers
- **Warm up** - No horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition. We will have a limit on the number of riders allowed in the warm-up arena at any time.
- **Lorry Park** - No horses/ponies to be left unattended when tied to the lorry/trailer and all droppings/dropped hay and rubbish to be picked up and taken home.
- **Dogs** - All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times
- **Water** – There is no running water on site so please ensure you bring your own supply

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW – postcode for SatNav RG41 4SU

M4 Junction 11 - Follow signs towards Shinfield and A327 to Arborfield. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A327 towards Arborfield/ Farnborough. At next roundabout (by Esso station) take first exit onto the Reading Road following the A327 into Arborfield. At the Arborfield Cross roundabout take the 3rd exit continuing along the A327. At the next roundabout, take the first exit into Langley Common Road, which becomes Barkham Road. Follow the road to a mini roundabout and go straight across (at the Bull Pub) follow the road up to another mini roundabout and turn left into Bearwood Road. Follow the road up to the top of the hill and turn left into Coombes Lane.

M4 Junction 10 - Take the ramp to the A329(m) towards Reading. Take the exit to Winnersh/Woodley/Earley. Follow signs towards Wokingham & Winnersh taking the first exit at traffic light roundabout towards Winnersh. At next traffic lights (Sainsbury's) turn right at King Street Lane. At next roundabout, turn left into Bearwood Road and follow the road till you see the right turn into Coombes Lane (Field is signposted from Bearwood Road).
