Class 1: 70cm (max):

Dressage Test: Pony Club Preliminary PC70 Dressage Test 2022
SJ & XC run as clear round

Class 2: 55cm (max):

Dressage Test: Pony Club Preliminary PC70 Dressage Test 2022
SJ & XC run as clear round

Class 3: 40cm (max):

Dressage Test: Pony Club Walk & Trot Test 2022
SJ & XC run as clear round (Lead Rein allowed - must be attached to noseband and not the bit). Leaders do so at their own risk

ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED TO THE XC START BY AN ADULT AS THERE IS A STRETCH TO PUBLIC HIGHWAY ON THE WAY TO THE START

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- **Course walk:** The Course may be walked from 2.00pm until 6.00pm on Friday 26th July and during the event providing no one gets in the way of riders. **STRICTLY NO DOGS**

- **Times will be posted on [Pony Club Results](#)** from 6.00 pm on Thursday 25th July 2024.
- Please **PRINT YOUR OWN NUMBER AT HOME AND BRING YOUR OWN NUMBER BIB. Please print THREE numbers 300 font size – two for rider, one for lorry/vehicle.**
- You must present your pony's **Passport on arrival** for inspection. Please note the current [Pony Club ruling on vaccinations](#).
- All **Hats** must be tagged with the **PINK** tag and all **body protectors** MUST be the latest PC standard, they are compulsory for XC and will be checked on arrival. **No air jackets under clothing.**
- **XC Clothing is acceptable for the Showjumping** phase to assist smooth running order.
- Please report to the **Tack Check Steward**, at least 15 minutes before your allotted time.
- Entrants must be accompanied by an adult at all times especially when going to and from the XC course as access involves a short stretch of road.
- A paramedic will be in attendance and a vet and farrier will be on call.
- Caterers will be in attendance on the day.
- Please do not leave litter or muck on the land and clear up around your lorry / trailer before you leave.
- **Ponies must NOT be left unattended tied to the outside of lorries or trailers.**
- **STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED ON SITE, EVEN IN VEHICLES OR ON THE COURSE WALK**

ANY QUERIES SHOULD BE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY OR ON THE DAY, THE ORGANISERS

RULES and CONDITIONS of ENTRY

1. This event will be run in accordance with the current [Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024](#) and the Hunter Trial section of the current Pony Club Eventing Organiser's Handbook.

HOWEVER, because this is a training event, some rules have been relaxed (see in this Schedule). If there is any dispute relating to the relaxation of the Rules, we reserve the right to revert fully to The Current Official Pony Club Rules as stated above.

There will be no eliminations as this is a clear round event only, but competitors are required to either retire or move onto the next obstacle after three refusals and may continue around the course making way for any following ponies. They may be required to move onto the next obstacle or retire from the course at the discretion of the Cross Country Steward.

In Class 1, only verbal advice is allowed by the helper.
In Class 2, only verbal advice is allowed by the helper.
In Class 3 - lead rein and/or appropriate help is allowed. The helper may guide the pony between SJ & XC obstacles in the interests of safety if it is napping or the helper thinks it may bolt. The helper may give verbal advice.
2. The decisions of the Organisers and The Official Steward are final. Any objections or complaints regarding any matter of any nature whatsoever must be submitted in writing to the Official Steward at the Secretary's desk with a £10 fee within 15 minutes of the incident.
3. Correct riding attire must be worn. Hard hats adhering to current Pony Club rules must be worn, tagged and fastened when mounted. It is **strongly recommended that a jockey skull cap is worn for cross-country** riding over fences. Body protectors, meeting [current Pony Club & BETA standards](#) are compulsory. Timing devices are forbidden. No head cams are allowed. [Jewellery as per Pony Club Rules.](#)
4. No competitor may enter the same pony in more than one class. No stallions will be allowed to attend or compete at this event.
5. NO withdrawals will be accepted without the production of a Medical or Veterinary certificate. In the event of a withdrawal, a £5 administration fee will be deducted. There will be no refunds after the closing date of entry.
6. The organisers retain the right to refuse entry at their discretion without stating a reason, and to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition.
7. Clear Round rosettes will be given out upon completion of the SJ & XC courses.
8. If the event is cancelled for any reason NOTIFICATION WILL BE POSTED ON THE VINE PC WEBSITE BY MIDDAY on Thursday 25th July 2024. Please do not telephone. If the event is cancelled, entry fees will be refunded less the sum of £5 per entry to cover administration.
9. Cruelty to ponies, misuse of whips or spurs, unseemly or aggressive behaviour, or blatant bad language by riders, parents/guardians, trainers or supporters, will not be tolerated, and you may be asked to leave.
10. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
11. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or landowner, his tenant(s), his contractors or his licensee accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
12. All entrants MUST be members of The Pony Club.
