Class 1 - Veteran Pony

Open to ponies 15 years and over, can be in-hand or ridden. Judged on condition and turn out of pony.

Class 2 - Tack and Turnout

Kindly Sponsored By ACEquestrian Livery Services, Coaching and Events

Judged on turnout of rider, pony and handler. This class may be inhand or Ridden.

Class 3 - Pony Club Pony

Kindly Sponsored by Equine Rebalance - Water Treadmill

Pony to be ridden independently. To include a small show, walk, trot and a small jump. Canter optional.

Class 4 - First Ridden

Pony to be ridden independently. Riders 10 years and under. Small Show in Walk and trot. Parents may be in arena to assist and give confidence to rider if needed.

Class 5 Lead Rein Pony

Riders 8 years and under. Judged on suitability of partnership and turnout.

Class 6 - Child Handler

In-hand class to show Pony being lead around in a group, Stand - up for inspection and trot up. All handlers must wear a riding hat.

Showjumping

All Showjumping classes kindly sponsored by - The New Inn

Approximately 2pm start – A friendly fun jumping competition for children. All classes may be assisted.

Class 10 – Cross Poles (at tiny height) Riders (12 years and under) can be led or assisted. This is a class for genuine novices / first timers to enjoy being part of a jumping show.

Rosette's 1st - 6th. All riders will receive a rosette for taking part.

Class 11 - 30 to 40cm jumping. Assisted (Riders 12 years and under)

Riders may be assisted but not led in this class. Places 1st - 6th. Unplaced riders will receive a rosette for taking part.

Class 12 – Horse and Hound (fun pairs relay).

Fun class for lead rein or off lead rein. Cross poles and small uprights. Pony and rider jump course and then handler and dog jump a shorter course.

Class 13a – Accumulator. 8 years and under. Fences - cross poles and small uprights up to 40cm jumping with one 50cm jumping bonus fence. Riders do not need to follow a course but must jump fences in the correct direction. Bonus fence can be jumped twice.

Riders may be assisted but not led. Places 1st - 6th

Class 13b – Accumulator. 8 years and over. Fences up to 60cm jumping with one 70cm jumping bonus fence. Riders do not need to follow a course but must jump fences in the correct direction. Bonus fence can be jumped twice.

Riders may be assisted but not led. Places 1st - 6th

Class 14 - 50cms jumping. Riders 12 years and under.

Riders may be assisted but not led. Places 1st - 6th

Additional cars will need to purchase an entry ticket to the event. Places to 6th with prizes for selected classes. All competitors in class 9 and 11 will receive a rosette.

All competitors must bring their ponies passports to the secretary's tent next to The Pony Club arena when collecting numbers.

Garth South Pony Club Show is held at - Wellington International Horse Trials, Highfield Farm, Hook, Heckfield, Hampshire, United Kingdom, RG27 0LE. Entrance to the show ground is from the B3349 Opposite the New Inn or as directed.

Health, Safety & Welfare: The Organiser's of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid or prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of all Organisers, officials and stewards.

Abandonment or Cancellation: The Organiser's reserve the right to retain up to ± 10.00 per competitor in the event of abandonment or cancellation. Refunds, if applicable, will be via Paypal.

Pony Club rules will apply. PC standard approved hats must be worn when mounted. Hats may be checked and if a competitor is a Pony Club Member, their hat should be tagged.

Back protectors are not compulsory but if used must be the current standard.

Passports: A valid pony passport and vaccination record:

- must accompany the horse / pony to all events
- must be available for inspection by the event officials
- must be produced on request at any time during the event

Vaccinations: Ponies can enter on a 12 month booster but please see main Pony Club website for vaccination Rules.

Horses/ponies must not be exercised near horse boxes and no lungeing is permitted.

Legal Liability: Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of the event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor Wellington Riding /Estate nor their licensee accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

A First Aider will be onsite at our show ring when classes are operating.

Please poo pick after your pony in the parking area.

PLEASE KEEP DOGS ON SHORT LEADS AT ALL TIMES (Do not use extending leads as these can be dangerous).

PLEASE TAKE ALL LITTER HOME OR PUT IN BINS PROVIDED.

Numbers: Will be given out on the day after declaring with a tagged pony club hat.

Refunds: Entry fees will be refunded on production a vet certificate or doctors' certificate after entries close.
