### **Class 2 – First Ridden**

*For children aged 12 & under, riding independently, to include a small show; canter optional, ponies 14.2 hh & under*

### **Class 3 – Pony Club / Junior Riding Horse or Pony**

*To be judged on the suitability of the pony / horse for Pony Club / Junior Riding Club activities, to include a small show with walk, trot & canter. Ridden only and off the lead rein*

### **Class 4 – Veteran Pony**

*Horses & ponies 16 years and over, ridden or in-hand*

### **Class 5 – Prettiest Mare / Handsome Gelding**

*Ridden or in-hand*

### **Class 6 – Child Handler**

*In-hand class to show pony being lead, stand for inspection and trot up*

**Class 8 CLEAR ROUND SHOW JUMPING WILL RUN IN THE ARENA  
FROM 10.00am – 12 noon  
(£5.00 per round – no more than two rounds per pony)**

**Classes 9-13 SHOW JUMPING 1.00pm start with classes running on  
(£10 per round – no more than four rounds per pony)**

**THERE WILL BE A SPECIAL AWARD IN EACH CLASS FOR THE BEST HORSEMANSHIP**

**ENTRY FEE PER CLASS £10.00 FOR INDIVIDUAL ROUNDS & £15.00 for PAIRS ROUNDS  
CLEAR ROUND JUMPING £5.00 PER ROUND**

**Please note that overuse of whips and / or spurs will result in a warning and possible elimination**

The event will run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024. Rosettes 1st-6th place.

All classes will take place ON GRASS. Single phase Show Jumping.

Classes 9-10 – age 10 and under, ponies 13.2 hh and under

Classes 11 & 11a – age 12 and under, ponies 14.2 hh and under classes

12 – 13a – age 14 and under, no height restrictions

No outside assistance except for classes 1-4

Class 9 **LEAD REIN JUMPING X-Poles to 30cm** (age 10 & under, ponies 13.2 hh and under)

Class 10 **30cm JUMPING OFF** the lead rein. One adult may be in the arena to encourage/support (age 10 & under, ponies 13.2 hh and under)

Class 11 **40cm JUMPING OFF** the lead rein. One adult may be in the arena to encourage/support (age 12 & under, ponies 14.2 hh and under)

Class 11a **40cm JUMPING PAIRS** (same criteria as Class 3)

Class 12 **50cm JUMPING** (age 14 & under)

Class 12a **50cm JUMPING PAIRS** (age 14 & under)

Class 13 **60cm JUMPING** - (age 14 & under)

Class 13a **60cm JUMPING PAIRS** - (age 14 & under)

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

PLEASE READ THIS PAGE CAREFULLY RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY LEGAL LIABILITY: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event, The Pony Club, the Riding Club and Newbury Show nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

PONIES / HORSES **MUST NOT** BE TIED TO THE OUTSIDE OF HORSEBOXES / TRAILERS AT ANY TIME, EVEN IF BEING SUPERVISED.

PLEASE TACK UP INSIDE AND WHEN LEADING KEEP THE BRIDLE ON.

**THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL CONCERNED.**

1. **INSURANCE:** Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Vine Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
2. All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
3. This event will be run under current Pony Club Rules throughout the day. Fully comprehensive rules are available on the main Pony Club website. <https://pcuk.org>
4. **Cancellation/Abandonment:** In the event of cancellation or abandonment, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £10.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
5. The judges' decision is final in all matters. Video evidence will not be accepted in any circumstances. The committee reserves the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the conditions or competitions as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion.
6. Protests or objections must be made in writing and addressed to the Official Steward accompanied with a £20 deposit, returnable if the objection is upheld, within 30 minutes of the incident occurring or within 30 minutes of the results being announced.
7. **Refunds:** No entry will be refunded after the entry closing date without the production of a Doctor's or Vet's certificate within 24 hours of the event. Any refunds will be subject to a charge of £5.00 per class entered.
8. **Hats:** All competitors must wear a protective Helmet manufactured to the minimum standards stated in the current Pony Club Rules. When mounted the chinstrap must be fastened at all times. Hats will be inspected when collecting numbers and must be tagged.
9. Medical Arm Bands may be worn on the arm or shoulder.
10. A Body Protector, to the Pony Club specifications may be worn in line with the current Pony Club Rules.
11. Air Jackets may be worn in line with the current Pony Club rules.
12. No jewelry or piercings may be worn. Long hair securely tied back / in hairnets.
13. Horses/ponies must not be exercised near horseboxes. Please park where instructed by the stewards. There will be warm-up areas.
14. Please ensure that your horse/pony has an up-to-date vaccination certificate/passport, which is available to be checked on the day if required.
15. EACH HORSE/PONY MAY ONLY JUMP ONCE IN ANY CLASS.
16. EACH HORSE/PONY MAY ENTER ONLY **FOUR** SHOWJUMPING CLASSES OR TWO ARENA EVENTING CLASSES.
17. Late entries may accepted on the day, space permitting, if entries for other classes have previously been received so that all details & membership numbers have been submitted.

18. Competitors must keep aware of ring progress to avoid conflicting/missing classes. Every effort will be made to accommodate clashes of classes.
19. All lead reins must be attached to either the noseband or a headcollar.
20. Horses and ponies must be over 4 years old on the day of the competition.
21. Please take all your litter home. Parking will be on grass. Please poo pick after your pony and do not muck out trailers or lorries in the parking area.
22. Passports: A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse / pony to all events, must be available for inspection by the event officials, must be produced on request at any other time during the event
23. Vaccinations – All horses / ponies must have been vaccinated within 12 months of the event not less than 7 days beforehand. Please see main Pony Club website for vaccination rules
24. REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by 15th September 2024
25. Please note that as a Condition of Entry, all details given at the time of entry MAY have to be shared with the Newbury & District Agricultural Society. By entering the show, you are consenting to this measure which is a requirement of NADAS should any biosecurity matters arise.

PLEASE KEEP DOGS ON SHORT LEADS AT ALL TIMES  
(Do not use extending leads as these can be dangerous).

PLEASE TAKE ALL LITTER HOME OR PUT IN BINS PROVIDED.
