SCHEDULE:

CLASS ONE: 70cm Spring Festival Qualifier
(Riders must be aged 13 years and under on 1st Jan 2024).

CLASS TWO: 80cm Spring Festival Qualifier

CLASS THREE: 90cm Spring Festival Qualifier

CLASS FOUR: 1m Spring Festival Qualifier

Competitors will jump a course of show jumps immediately followed by a course of cross-country style fences.

- NO STOPWATCHES ARE PERMITTED
- All Classes will be run as single phase
- All class winners will be decided on an Optimum Time

ROSETTES to sixth place. All prize giving is unmounted, and will take place after each class.

ENTRY FEES: £39.00 per class plus booking fee (First aid cover included)

AREA 13 TEAM ENTRIES - Closing Date Monday 21st October 2024

Individual Entries closing date 25th October 2024.

Entries will close before if classes are full and a waiting list will be held.

TEAMS: Branches/Centres may enter a team of three members in each section of the Area Qualifier competitions. The team members must compete in the same level of competition. The team must comprise three members and all three scores count. There will be NO Area/Mixed Teams.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & GENERAL INFORMATION

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

1. This event will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Arena Eventing Rules 2024, Pony Club Spring Festival England and Wales 2025 – Arena Eventing Rules, both of which are available on www.pcuk.org
2. All competitors must be members of the Pony Club both at the closing date for entries to the competition and at the date of the competition.
3. A combination of horse and rider can compete at two adjacent levels of the same sport.
4. No horse may be ridden more than once in the same class.
5. Riders may ride a maximum of three horses at the Area Competition and two horses at the Championships in any one class. Horses may only be ridden by one rider in a class at the Area Competitions and at the Championships.
6. All horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old on the day of competition. Stallions are allowed with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must have stallion discs and ribbons on; any stallion ridden by a Pony Club member must have written permission from their DC/Centre Proprietor which must be emailed to the Entries Secretary.
7. Vaccinations – Pony Club rules on vaccinations apply – see biosecurity policy on <https://pcuk.org/about-us/policies/> DC's will be required to vouch that all their branch competitors meet the requirement. Spot checks may be made.
8. Substitutions for this event will be accepted, but must be emailed to the Entries Secretary. Substitutions for the Championships - After the closing date of declarations, no substitutions may be made of horses or riders except in cases of illness, lameness or other unavoidable circumstances which must be certified by the District Commissioner or their appointed Representative.

10. Withdrawal refunds will only be given on the receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within 24 hrs of the event, and will be subject to an admin charge of £10.
11. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded less admin charge of £5.00 per class.
12. TIMES will be available via www.ponyclubresults.co.uk, and also via the Vine PC website www.branches.pcuk.org/vine/ on or before 1st Nov 2024 .
13. Cross Country compliant XC kit and saddlery should be worn (including Back protectors and long sleeves). The Pony Club Saddlery and Dress rules apply. Please see the Pony Club website. (www.pcuk.org)

14. All Pony Club members must have current hat tags.

15. Stop Watches are not permitted.

16. Spurs may be worn when riding, but must comply with Pony Club rules, and MUST be removed for prize giving and when not mounted. Misuse of spurs by any competitor will be recorded and reported and may result in disqualification from the competition.

17. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their estimated time – please be ready. If you miss your turn, you may have to wait until the end of the class and will only be able to jump if time allows.

18. Indoor warm-up (adjacent to Arena) – the number of competitors will be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the Arena indoor warm-up. No lungeing is allowed at Wellington Riding.

19. Children (under 16) must not jump in either warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.

20. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

21. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize- giving for that class.

22. INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

23. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.

24. Participants attend at their own risk; neither Vine Pony Club, The Pony Club nor Wellington Riding will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.

25. **No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision.** Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave it in the lorry park.

26. REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT. The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the branch and centre activities we offer. Reasonable adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty.
