Class 1. TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL ODE: entry fee £60pp

(any combination entering this class may not enter class 2 or 3)

- Riders must be 16 years and under on 01/01/2024
- Dressage Test: PC Introduction to Dressage Test 2019 Can be ridden in any normal riding bit.
- Dressage test may be commanded
- Jumping height 60cm max
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Neither riders nor Combinations to have competed at BE. Combination must not have been placed 8th or above at 70cm Regionals ODE
- **Show Jumping** will take place before the Cross Country. For Technical Eliminations ONLY: Competitors eliminated Show Jumping may be allowed to go Cross Country at the discretion of the Show Jumping Judge.
- **Cross Country**. Competitors are eliminated after one fall or for 3 refusals at any one jump or 4 refusals over whole course. Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk.
- No outside assistance.

Class 2. TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL DRESSAGE: entry fee £25pp

- Riders must be 16 years and under on 01/01/2024
- Dressage Test: PC Introduction to Dressage Test 2019. May be ridden in any normal riding bit.
- May be commanded
- Individuals or Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Combination not to have qualified for the Regional Championships at Area/Regional Grassroots or above or above BD Prelim level and not to have been placed in the top 8 in their arena at Regional Champs PC70 Dressage

Class 3. TEAMS & INDIVIDUAL SHOW JUMPING – 60cm: entry fee £30pp

- Riders must be 16 years and under on 01/01/2024
- Individual class prizes may be split by age if there are sufficient entries.
- Teams of 3 or 4. Best 3 scores to count.
- Jumps approximately 55cm in 1st round and 60cm in 2nd round. 2nd round to be timed.
- Teams/Riders eliminated in 1st round may still jump in 2nd round.
- Combination not to have been placed 8th or above in Regional PC70 Championships or above, or completed any British Showjumping competition at 70cm or more in the first round.
- Combination of pony & rider must not have any BS winnings in the previous 2 years.
- No ponies to have been registered JA in the previous 12 months

Class 4. INDIVIDUAL SHOWJUMPING – 50cm: entry fee £25pp

- Riders must be 15 years and under on 01/01/2024
- Jumps 50cm in 1st phase, 2nd phase timed
- Combination not to have competed at Area or Regional PC70 or above, or any British Showjumping competition at 80cm or more in the first round or have gone double clear at the Regional Champs PC70 show jumping class.
- Combination of pony & rider must not have any BS winnings in the previous 2 years
- No ponies to have been registered JA in the previous 12 months

Class 5. INDIVIDUAL DRESSAGE Walk & Trot: entry fee £20pp

- Riders any age
- Dressage Test: Pony Club Walk & Trot Test 2022. May be ridden in any normal riding bit.
- May be commanded
- Combination not to have been placed in the top 8 in their arena at Regional Champs PC70 Dressage

TACK: All competitors must report to their respective stewards at least 20 minutes before their time to compete, for tack check.

Please print THREE copies of your number, two for your number bib and one to be displayed in the windscreen of your vehicle at all times. *You need to provide your own number bib*

COURSE WALK: The Horse Trials courses (SJ and XC) may be walked between 2pm &

5pm on Saturday 21st September 2024

Class 1: ODE $1^{st} - 8^{th}$ Individuals; $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ Teams Class 2: DRESSAGE $1^{st} - 8^{th}$ Individuals; $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ Teams Class 3: SHOW JUMPING $1^{st} - 8^{th}$ Individuals: $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ Teams

Class 4: SHOW JUMPING 1st – 10th Individuals Class 5: DRESSAGE 1st – 10th Individuals

RULES

- Any combination entering Class 1 ODE may NOT enter any other Class.
- All Classes to be run under the relevant discipline Pony Club Rules 2024
- Correct riding attire in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Rules 2024 must be worn when mounted. Hats must be worn to the Pony Club specifications for 2024 (no fixed peaks). A body protector, to the Pony Club specifications 2024 is compulsory for the cross-country phase and is recommended for showjumping. Body protectors may be worn outside jackets for all disciplines. If you are wearing an air jacket, please abide by the Pony Club rules and if you have a body protector that requires a key, please ensure a spare is lodged with the secretary.
- Please treat all officials with respect: they are all volunteers and have given up their day for your and your child's benefit.
- On the day of the competition, horses may only be ridden by the competitor in designated warm up areas and must only walk in the horsebox park. No lunging is allowed in the horsebox park, if you need to lunge, please see the Secretary to know where to do this.
- The Organisers retain the right to retain £5.00 entry fee in the event of cancellation.
- No refunds without the production of a doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
- The judge's decision is final in all cases. Video evidence will not be accepted in any circumstances. Objections are to be lodged with the Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (returnable if the objection is upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident occurring. Objections can only be lodged by the DC/Centre Proprietor or their official representative.
- Dogs to be always kept on a short lead
- Please do not muck out Lorries/trailers into the field, and do not leave any litter. Please remove any droppings & hay.
- TACK Competitors will not be allowed to start if their tack is not deemed to be safe. All competitors must report to their respective stewards at least 20 minutes before their time to compete, for tack check. Tack must be in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Discipline Rule Book 2024
