CLASSES

CLASS 1 X POLES

Competitors may be led or assisted in the arena. All competitors must be 12 or under.

CLASS 2 40cm

Competitors may be led or assisted in the arena.

Classes 3-7 are open to all, there is to be no assistance in the arena.

CLASS 3 50cm

CLASS 4 PC60

CLASS 5 PC70

CLASS 6 PC80

Entry fees include first aid. All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

Useful information

- All classes will be held in the indoor arena.
- Numbers in the warm-up area will be limited. Please do not enter the warm-up arena until you have been invited by the steward.
- All horses/ponies outside of arena/warm-up areas should be ridden in walk to ensure the safety of all spectators and pedestrians.
- Don't forget your Pony Club badge, tie/stock. Hats must be tagged with current standard tag (pink)

Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League 2024/2025

- Area 13 Spring Festival Show Jumping Qualifier – 2 February 2025



League Rules:

- This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only and they must be a current member throughout the league.
- League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League competitions in classes that are for PC60 - PC110.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter - they get 1 point for each Class they participate in, 2 points for a double clear round and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from a maximum of 2 Classes at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule, but the results will be taken from the combination's best 2 rounds on the day.
- Points will be counted from all 6 competitions across all Classes from PC60 – PC110 resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League Champion and rosettes are from 1st to 10th place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League will take place on Sunday 2 February at the Area 13 Show Jumping Spring Festival Qualifier at BCA.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admissions granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

1. Health & Safety – Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety are observed under Pony Club guidance. Competitors are expected to adhere to requests from officials as required.
2. Insurance – Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by the Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover.
3. Judging – The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made under the Pony Club rules 2024.
4. The organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the schedule.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without stating a reason for doing so and the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places him/her or others in danger or fails to observe the rules.
6. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024.
7. There will be unmounted prize giving after each class. Prize winning competitors are expected to be properly dressed as for competition for the prize giving.
8. All hats to be worn when mounted and must be tagged with pink Pony Club hat tags. Hats must conform to the current Pony Club standards with the chin strap fastened at all times when mounted.
9. Competitors should familiarise themselves with the current Pony Club whip rules, which will be strictly enforced.
10. Competitors should familiarise themselves with the Pony Club dress code.
11. No jewellery may be worn. If earrings cannot be removed, they must be taped.
12. In the event of the competition being cancelled refunds will be processed by Entrymaster.
13. Refunds (less the administration charge of £6.50) will only be given on withdrawal prior to the closing date. Withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded.
14. In the event of the competition being abandoned a refund of 75% will be given.
15. Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the organisers and will be subject to a £5 late entry fee.
16. Horses and ponies competing may only be ridden at the venue by the member who is entered to compete.
17. Competition numbers must be displayed at all times while at the venue.
18. Horses and ponies may only be tied to the outside of the trailer if a responsible adult is present. Competitors who leave unattended horses/ponies may be subject to elimination.
19. You are expected to clear up any droppings/hay from around your parking area.
20. Please do not hang haynets outside to the outside of horseboxes/trailers.
21. Passports – a valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to all events and must be produced for inspection when requested by organising officials.
