Entry Fee £12 + £3 per rider first aid cover

Led or assisted competitors may not enter the following classes. Unassisted competitors may not enter classes that are 60cms or higher

Classes 9 10,12,13 and 14 are open to teams and Individuals Entry Fee £15 + £3 per Rider first aid cover

The following classes are run as Single Phase except for Class 11

Class 9: 50cms (Does not count for winter league points)

Class 10: PC 60cms

Class 11: 60-70cm Pairs Entry Fee £25 per pair + £3 per rider first aid cover

League Rules:

- This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only and they must be a current member throughout the league.
- League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League competitions in classes that are for PC60 PC110.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in, 2 points for a double clear round and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from a maximum of 2 Classes at each show. Note:
 Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule but the results will be taken from the combination's best 2 rounds on the day.
- Points will be counted from all 6 competitions across all Classes from PC60 PC110 resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League Champion and rosettes are from 1st to 10th place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League will take place on Sunday 2 February at the Area 13 Show Jumping Spring Festival Qualifier at BCA.

LEAGUE RULES:

- This League is for Pony Club Members only.
- League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Dressage League competitions.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- N.B. In Classes 1 and 2, Section B will not count towards Winter Dressage League Points.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may
 compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule.
- Points will be counted from all 5 competitions across all Classes resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Dressage League Champion and rosettes are down to 10th place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Dressage League will take place on Sunday 23 February at the Petersfield Dressage competition.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

- Health & Safety Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- Legal Liability Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- Reasonable Adjustment: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by 22nd October 2024.  - 1. Telephone entries or entries without the appropriate fee will not be accepted.
 - 2. In the event of cancellation £4.00 per entry will be retained to cover administration costs.
 - 3. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the classes they think fit, alter advertised times or refuse entry without stating reason.
 - 4. All classes will be judged in accordance with Pony Club Rules (

- 5. The judge's decision is final.
- 6. Horses/Ponies must compete in the order as times given.
- 7. No Horse/Pony under the age of 4 may compete.
- 8. Only Pony Club approved hats may be worn.
- 9. No earrings or any other jewellery.
- 10. Objections accompanied by a deposit of £10.00 must be made in writing to the Secretary within 15minutes of the incident. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
- 11. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and are not allowed in the schools or gallery.
- 12. The organisers, the officers, servants or agents shall be under no liability for injury, loss or damage, however occasioned, suffered by competitors, spectators, their property, servants or horses/ponies in connection with, or arising out of the show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers be acquitted of any liability whatsoever.
- 13. No entry fee will be refunded without a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
- 14. Please avoid Warnham Village and Mayes Lane and follow the road signs on the A24 and A29 to "Equestrian Centre". The entrance to the Showground is on Three Stiles Road.
