To Start Approx 9.00am-12:00 Outdoor Arena 1
£12 entry + £3 for First Aid (per rider only)

The classes in this arena are an introduction to show jumping classes, run by an instructor who is available to help. All classes to have same course and riders can be assisted or on lead rein. Classed in this arena are not part of the Area 13 SJ League. Rosettes for all competitors in Class 1 and 1st - 6th placings classes 2 & 3

Class 1 - Poles on the floor

Class 2: Cross Poles

Class 3: 40cm

To Start Approx 9.00am Indoor Arena 2
£15 entry + £3 for First Aid (per rider only)

Placings 1st- 6th in all classes and points for Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League in Classes 5-10 only.

Class 4: 50cm - Open to any individual

Class 5: 60cm - Open to any individual

Class 6: 70cm - Open to any individual

Class 7: 80cm - Open to any individual

Class 8: 90cm - Open to any individual

Class 9: 1m - Open to any individual

Class 10:110cm - Open to any individual.

The highest placed Pony Club member in this class will be given one of the Area 13 places to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 18 May 2025 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section below).



Things to note on the day:

- **Classes will all be Single Phase.**
- **Bib numbers:** Please print your own numbers for your bib or bridle number. 1 x printed number to be left visible in your lorry/car.
- **Hats & Passports:** Riders to declare on the day with their hats & passports. All hats to have been tagged with the Pink hat tags prior to arriving at the competition. We will do spot checks on passports, so please ensure you have them with you.
- **Warm up:** Riders in the warm up will be limited. This information will be made available to you at the warm-up arena and the numbers will be controlled dependent upon space available.
- **Lorry Park:** No horses/ponies to be left unattended when tied to the lorry/trailer and all droppings/dropped hay and rubbish to be picked up and taken home.
- **Dogs:** All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.

Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League 2024/2025

The shows included in the league are:

- Hambleton Hunt North PC – Sunday 27 October 2024
- Lord Leconfield Hunt PC – Wednesday 30 October 2024
- Garth Hunt PC – Saturday 9 November 2024
- Wokingham PC – Sunday 17 November 2024
- Bisley & Sandown Chase PC – Sunday 5 January 2025
- Area 13 Spring Festival Show Jumping Qualifier – Sunday 2 February 2025



League Rules:

- This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only and they must be a current member throughout the league.
- League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League competitions in classes that are for PC60 - PC110.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter - they get 1 point for each Class they participate in, 2 points for a double clear round and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from a maximum of 2 Classes at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule, but the results will be taken from the combination's best 2 rounds on the day.
- Points will be counted from all 6 competitions across all Classes from PC60 – PC110 resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League Champion and rosettes are from 1st to 10th place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League will take place on Sunday 2 February at the Area 13 Show Jumping Spring Festival Qualifier at BCA.

Area 13 Royal Windsor Horse Show Tickets 2025

The highest placed Pony Club member in Class 10 - PC110 will be given one of the Area 13 places to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 18 May 2025 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section of this schedule).



Rules/eligibility:

- Must be a member on date of qualifying competition AND for the Windsor date.
- Must have had no more than 16 jumping faults.
- RIDER can only qualify for Windsor on one horse. (If the rider wins two of the competitions on different horses, they select which one they want to take to Windsor. The Windsor qualification passes down to the next rider at that competition assuming they meet the eligibility requirements.
- Branches with members qualified through the competitions will not be able to put other names into the main draw but may put other names into the reserve draw.
- Riders who have represented Area13 at Windsor Show Jumping on TWO or more previous occasions will not be eligible to qualify this year.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

- **Health & Safety** - Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- **Legal Liability** - Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- **Reasonable Adjustment:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by 10 November 2024. - **Rule Books** - A copy of the most recent Pony Club Show jumping Rules are found here <https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/>
- **Objections** - The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 not later than 20 minutes after the incident.
- **Refusal of Entries** - The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- **Refunds** - Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition.
- **Event Cancellation** - In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the Wokingham PC website. Monies will be refunded less £7.50 per entry administration fee.
- **Horse Age** - Horses or ponies must be 4 years or over on the day of the show.
- **Riders** - No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.
- **Dress Rules** - The Pony Club Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced.
- **No spurs** to be worn in classes 1-4
- **Rider Hats** to have the Pink hat tags in order for rider to compete.
- **Passports** - There will be spot checks on passports on the day. All riders to declare with their passport.
- **Horse Vaccinations:** in line with the most up to date PC Rules on horse vaccinations (Jan 2024).
