<u>Please note that Spurs may not be worn in any class unless you have</u> <u>your YELLOW</u> hat tag

CLASS 1: PC WALK & TROT DRESSAGE TEST 2022: commanders permitted in both sections

Section A: Open to riders 12 years and under on the day

Section B: Open to all ages (this section will not count for League Points)

No combination to have competed at PC Grassroots Level or above in either section

CLASS 2: PRELIMINARY PC70 DRESSAGE TEST 2022: commanders permitted in both sections

Section A: Open to riders 13 years and under on the day

Section B: Open to all ages (this section will not count for League Points)

No combination to have competed at PC Novice Level or above in either section

For classes 3 – 6 Section A – please see eligibility criteria in the current Spring Festival Rules (link on front of schedule): Section 5.2

CLASS 3: GRASSROOTS DRESSAGE TEST 2018: commanders permitted in both Sections

ROSETTES:

Individuals to 8th place in each Section. Class Sections may be amalgamated depending on numbers.

Teams to 6th place.

The organisers reserve the right to alter the number of prizes if entries are higher or lower than expected.

For Classes 3 – 6 <u>Qualifying</u> Teams may be made up of 3 riders from a Pony Club Branch within Section A of each Class with all placings to count.

For Classes 1 & 2 – Teams may be made up of 3 or 4 members in the Class, at least 2 combinations must be in section A, best 3 placings to count.

Teams to be entered by a Team Manager and emailed to the Secretary Commanders – see individual class rules

LEAGUE RULES:

- ➤ This League is for Pony Club Members only you must be a paid up member on the day of competition.
- ➤ League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Dressage League competitions.
- ➤ Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- ➤ N.B. In Classes 1 and 2, Section B will not count towards Winter Dressage League Points.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule.
- ➤ Points will be counted from all 5 competitions across all Classes resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Dressage League Champion and rosettes are down to 10th place.
- ➤ Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Dressage League will take place on Sunday 23 February at the Petersfield Dressage competition.

IMPORTANT NOTE RE PARKING

Parking on the day will be limited, please obey the parking stewards at all times; they will advise where to park.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.

- ➤ In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £5.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
- Any objection should be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £25.00. After due consideration of the objection, the Judge or Chief Steward's decision is final.
- Withdrawals: £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £5.00 admin fee).
- No lungeing on show ground.
- Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Legal Liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Health and Safety: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

Reasonable Adjustment: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the branch and centre activities we offer.
