There is a one-off fee of £3.00 per rider (NOT per class) to go towards first aid cover.

CLASS 1 50cm in 1st phase. Riders may be assisted in this class, but Leading Rein will not be accepted. 12 yrs & under. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 70cm or above. This class is NOT part of the Area 13 Showjumping League. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00
 CLASS 2 PC60 - 60cm in 1st phase. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 80cm or above. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00

CLASS 3 PC70 - 70cm in 1st phase. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 90cm or above. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18

CLASS 4 PC80 - 80cm in 1st phase. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00

CLASS 5 PC90 - 90cm in 1st phase Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00

CLASS 6 PC100 - 100cm in first phase. Single phase Entry fee £18

CLASS 7 PC110 - 110cm in 1st phase. Single phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00

Spurs Rule, Area 13 League Rules and RWHS Qualifying Rules below

# RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: PLEASE READ

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

No rider numbers will be issued at the venue, you will need to provide your own bib and bib number. No bridle numbers please.

PLEASE BRING YOUR HAT (AND BODY PROTECTOR, IF BEING WORN) TO THE ENTRY SECRETARY OFFICE FOR CHECKING / TAGGING. If a rider wants to ride in spurs they MUST have the PC approved tag on their hat. No tag, no spurs!

Ponies / horses must not be left tied to the outside of horse boxes/trailers at any time.

#### No dogs allowed at the venue.

- This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025, with the exception of the new Spur Rule, which is already current. Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced, including spur and whip rules. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules. Please refer to the main Pony Club website for a downloadable copy of the rule book.
- The judge's decision is **final**. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 no later than 20 minutes after the incident.
- ➤ The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- Entry fees will only be refunded at the discretion of the organisers and on production of a valid vet's or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition. In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the B&SC website. Monies will be refunded less £7.50 per entry administration fee.
- No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition. Horses and ponies must be over 4 years of age. Vaccinations must be up to date spot checks will be made.

**HEALTH AND SAFETY:** The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to prevent and avoid accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, and all the Officials and Stewards.

**LEGAL LIABILITY:** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

**Insurance**: Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Bisley & Sandown Chase Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you. **REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that wherever possible members are able to access all aspects of this competition. This includes any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for RA must be made BEFORE the day of the competition.

## **League Rules:**

- > This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only and they must be a current member throughout the league.
- ➤ League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League competitions in classes that are for PC60 PC110.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in, 2 points for a double clear round and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, going down to 1 point for 10<sup>th</sup> place across all the classes.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from a maximum of 2 Classes at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule, but the results will be taken from the combination's best 2 rounds on the day.
- ▶ Points will be counted from all 6 competitions across all Classes from PC60 PC110 resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League Champion and rosettes are from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League will take place on Sunday 2 February at the Area 13 Show Jumping Spring Festival Qualifier at BCA.

# **Area 13 Royal Windsor Horse Show Tickets 2025**

The highest placed Pony Club member in Class 10 - PC110 will be given one of the Area 13 places to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 18 May 2025 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section of this schedule).



#### **Rules/eligibility:**

- ➤ Must be a member on date of qualifying competition AND for the Windsor date.
- Must have had no more than 16 jumping faults.
- ➤ RIDER can only qualify for Windsor on one horse. (If the rider wins two of the competitions on different horses, they select which one they want to take to Windsor. The Windsor qualification passes down to the next rider at that competition assuming they meet the eligibility requirements.
- > Branches with members qualified through the competitions will not be able to put other names into the main draw but may put other names into the reserve draw.
- ➤ Riders who have represented Area13 at Windsor Show Jumping on TWO or more previous occasions will not be eligible to qualify this year.
