Class 1:	Tiny/35cm	Rider Age limit: 12 yrs and under. Riders may be assisted / led. Combination may not compete in Classes 3, 4, 5 or 6.
Class 2:	40/50cm	Rider Age limit: 12 yrs and under. Riders may be assisted / led. Combination may not compete in Classes 4, 5 or 6. Style & Individual Sponsored by: FROST ROOFING
Class 3:	60cm	Combination may not compete in Classes 1, 5 or 6. Individual Sponsored by: THERAPLATE SOUTH CENTRAL
Class 4:	PC70	Combination may not compete in Classes 1, 2 or 6. Style & Individual Sponsored by: MICHAELA WILSON - PERMANENT MAKEUP ARTIST
Class 5:	PC80	Combination may not compete in Classes 1, 2 or 3. Individual Sponsored by: GREENS REMOVALS
Class 6:	PC90	Combination may not compete in Classes 1,2, 3 or 4.

MH Photos has donated a gift voucher for the winner of each class in the Individual Section.

Competitors jump one round of a mixture of show jumps and cross-country style jumps with the second section being timed. Jumping penalties from both sections will count and the fastest time with the fewest jumping penalties will decide the placings.

Style/Appearance Rules:

Competitors are automatically entered into this element of the competition. Each rider to be judged on the following:

- **1.** Rhythm
- 2. Approach
- 3. Rider position and seat
- **4.** Partnership/harmony
- **5.** Overall impression/appearance

Entry Fees:

- Individual entry £24 (Includes Style/Appearance Competition).
- First Aid fee £3 per competitor.

Rules of Event and Conditions of Entry

- 1. <u>Health, Safety and Welfare:</u> The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- 2. <u>Legal Liability:</u> Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- Rule Books: This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Arena Eventing Rules
 2024, with the amendment of fasted time not optimal time. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules. Please refer to the main Pony Club website for full rule book.
- 4. <u>Event Cancellation:</u> In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on SC&SH PC website, Monies will be refunded less £7.50 per entry administration fee.
- Objections: The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit
 of £20 within 30 minutes of the incident. If the complaint is not upheld, then the £20 will be
 considered forfeit.
- 6. <u>Refusal of Entries:</u> The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- 7. **Refunds:** Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition.
- 8. <u>Horses:</u> Horses or ponies must be 4 years or over on the day of the show and no horse/pony can compete more than once in a class and no more than 2 different classes.
- 9. **Riders:** No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor and take place only in the collecting ring/designated warm up area. Horses/ponies must be walked in all other areas.
- 10. <u>Parking Area:</u> Please ensure that the area around your horseboxes / trailers are left clean and tidy and in particular that all droppings and hay are cleared up. Horses and ponies tied up to the outside of horseboxes or trailers must not be left unattended.
- 11. <u>Rider Hats:</u> Must conform to the latest hat standards and be tagged with pink tags please, all Pony Club members wishing to wear spurs on the day will also need the yellow hat tag to identify they have completed their C+ riding test or the spurs test. Pink hat tags may be requested for £1.
- 12. Passports: There will be spot checks on passports on the day. All riders to declare with their passport.
- 13. Horse Vaccinations: In line with the most up to date PC rules on horse vaccinations.
- 14. Long sleeved jackets/shirts/xc tops must be worn with a body protector to current PC standards which can be found here.
- 15. **TIMES**: They will be available via my riding life, on or before 17th Jan 2025.
- 16. <u>Dogs</u>: They must be always kept on leads and remain the responsibility of the owner. If any dog is found loose on the College grounds unattended, then appropriate action will be taken. Dogs are not allowed into the viewing gallery. These are the venues rules.
- **17.** Reasonable Adjustment: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the branch and centre activities we offer. Reasonable adjustments are any actions that help reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty.
