## The Area 13 Winter Dressage Competition 2024/25

- Area 13 Spring Festival Qualifier – Sunday 26 January 2025
- South Berkshire Pony Club – Sunday, 9 February 2025
- Petersfield Pony Club – Sunday, 23 February 2025

### League Rules and Information

- This League is for Pony Club Members only.
- League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Dressage League competitions.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter - they get 1 point for each Class they participate in and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, going down to 1 point for 10<sup>th</sup> place across all the classes.
- ***N.B. Class 1, Sections A1 and B and Class 2, Section B will not count towards Winter Dressage League Points.***
- Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule.
- Points will be counted from all 5 competitions across all Classes resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Dressage League Champion and rosettes are down to 10<sup>th</sup> place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Dressage League will take place on Sunday, 23 February at the Petersfield Dressage competition.

### **Class 1: PC Walk and Trot Dressage Test 2022; No spurs allowed**

- Section A1: Lead rein - Riders 10 years and under on the day  
*\*Section A1 does not count for Winter Dressage League Points*
- Section A2: Riders 12 years and under on the day
- Section B: Open to all ages  
*\*Section B does not count for Winter Dressage League Points*

No horse and rider combination may ride in both Section A1 and A2

No rider to have competed at PC Novice level or above in any section.

### **Class 2: Preliminary PC70 Dressage Test 2022; No spurs allowed**

- Section A: Open to all riders 13 years and under on the day
- Section B: Open to all ages  
*\*Section B does not count for Winter Dressage League Points*

No rider to have competed at PC novice level or above in either section.

Horse and rider combinations entering any classes 3 and 4 are not allowed to enter classes 1 or 2.

Pony Club members wishing to wear spurs in classes 3 & 4 must have a yellow spurs hat tag; this will be checked.

### **Class 3: Grassroots PC80 Dressage Test 2018**

Open to all.

### **Class 4: Novice, Intermediate and Open**

Rosettes to be awarded as one class, with Winter Dressage League Points awarded for each section/test

Should entries allow, sections/tests will be run as individual classes

- PC Novice Dressage Test 2020
- PC Intermediate Dressage Test 2024
- PC Open Dressage Test 2020

Open to all.

Working in will be on an outdoor surface with no lunging. Tests ridden indoors. There may be a limit to the number of riders allowed in the designated warm up area at any one time.

Competitors must report to the Tack Check Steward 15 minutes before the time allotted for their test

Running order subject to change depending on entries.

Sheets can be collected on the day once results are published or alternatively you may leave a stamp addressed envelope and your test will be posted to you.

## Rules and Conditions of Entry

- ❖ No horse or pony may be ridden more than once per class and ponies and horses must be over 4 years old on the day of competition.
- ❖ All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
- ❖ The Judge's decision is final.
- ❖ The Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the Schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
- ❖ In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £5.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
- ❖ Please read all rules as above on The Pony Club website: [The Pony Club](#). A copy of the Rule Book will be held with the Secretary on the day of the competition.
- ❖ Any objections in writing to be accompanied by a deposit of £10. Judges' decision is final.
- ❖ Withdrawals - £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £5.00 admin fee).
- ❖ Competitors are requested not to muck out horse boxes on the showground and to pick up all droppings from the car park.
- ❖ **No dogs allowed under any circumstances.**
- ❖ No numbers will be issued at the venue. Please use bridle or numnah numbers.
- ❖ **Hats:** Securely fastened hard hats must be worn at all times by everyone when mounted. Hats should be tagged and must conform to Pony Club Rules 2025. All hats to be checked when collecting numbers. Dark blue, black or brown hats only.
- ❖ **Spurs,** if worn, must comply with Pony Club 2025 Rules. PC Spurs hat tags will be checked.
- ❖ **Body Protectors (if worn) must comply with BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label) being the only acceptable safety standard.**
- ❖ We will be publishing competitors names and results on our websites. This will include competitors name, pony name, branch and full results. If you wish your details to be excluded from these publications, please make a note of this on your entry.
- ❖ **Reasonable Adjustment:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of this competition. This includes any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for RA must be made no later than 31 January 2025 by emailing the organiser.
- ❖ **Legal liability:** save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or the Pony Club or any agent, employee or representative of their bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant accepts and liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to any horse, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents or accessories or any other person or properties whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- ❖ Competitors who are not members of The Pony Club will not be covered by Pony Club insurance and should have their own third-party cover. South Berkshire Pony Club and the organisers are not legally responsible for non-members and their insurance will not cover you.
- ❖ **Health and Safety:** organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials, and stewards.
- ❖ In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an admin fee of £5 per competitor.
