Class 5 - PC110 Riders - Royal Windsor Horse Show Place

The highest placed eligible rider in Class 5 - PC110 Grand Prix Spring Festival Area 13 Qualifier - will be given an Area 13 place to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 18 May 2025 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section of this schedule).

Important Information

Class 1 & 2 **ENTRY FEE - £18 - To be in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping 2025 Rule Book will be single phase.**

Classes 3, 4, 5 & 6 **ENTRY FEE - £20 - Area Competitions and the Championships Spring Festival Area will run in accordance with the current Pony Club Show Jumping Rule Book and The Pony Club Spring Festival 2025 Rules.** Due to the daylight restrictions at this time of year, this class will be run as single phase rather than table A7. Class faults are accumulated in both sections with all riders going through to the timed part of the course against the clock.

First Aid **First Aid - £3.00 - All riders are subject to this fee.**

Placings

Classes 1 & 2 – Rosettes from 1st to 6th place

Qualifier Classes 3, 4, 5 & 6 – Rosettes from 1st to 8th place with Sashes for Class Winners

Teams – Rosettes from 1st to 6th Place with Sashes for Winning Team

This competition is the final for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League. Prizegiving will take place here at the end of the day.

The Qualifying Class competition comprises:

The individual competition – the scores for all competitors in the competition automatically count for this competition. It is also open to all competitors in the team competition (below).

The team competition – open to teams that must consist of three members from each Branch/Centre with all three scores to count.

Spring Festival Qualifier Rules and Qualifications:

Competitors are responsible for checking that both the rider and their horses are eligible to compete in these classes. See the [Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Rules](#).

In Classes 3, 4 & 5 places 1-4 will qualify for the Championships if there are up to 50 entries and then on a ratio basis of 1 additional qualifying place per 10 additional entries. In Class 6 the top 4 places will qualify for the Championships. This will increase by 1 additional qualifying place if there are more than 15 starters. The winning team of 3 at each level at the Area competition will also qualify the championships.

Prize giving for each class will be done approx 15-20 mins after the class ends.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON THE DAY

- **Numbers:** No numbers will be issued at the venue. Please use your own bridle or numnah numbers.
- **Hats & Passports** – Riders to declare on the day with their passports and hats. Passports will be checked on the day. All hats to have been tagged with the Pink hat tags prior to arriving at the competition.
- **Spurs** – anyone wanting to ride in spurs must have the PC approved tag on their hat. No tag, no spurs
- **Warm up** – Numbers in the Warm up will be limited and managed by the Warm Up steward on the day.
- **Prizegiving** – Competitors are expected to be correctly dressed for prizegiving.
- **Lorry Park** - No horses/ponies to be left unattended outside of horse boxes/trailer. All droppings/dropped hay and rubbish to be picked up and taken home.
- **Dogs** - All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

1. **Health & Safety** - Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
2. **Legal Liability** - Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
3. **Insurance:** Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Wokingham Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
4. **Reasonable Adjustments:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that wherever possible members are
5. able to access all aspects of this competition. This includes any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for RA must be made at least **7 days before the day of the competition**.
6. **Rule Books** - This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025 and the [Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Rules](#) with the exception of the new Spur Rule, which is already current. Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced, including spur and whip rules. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules.
7. **Objections** - The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 not later than 20 minutes after the incident.
8. **Refusal of Entries** - The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
9. **Refunds** - Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition.
10. **Event Cancellation** - In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the Wokingham PC website and Pony Club Results. Monies will be refunded less £7.50 per entry administration fee.
11. **Horses** - No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition. Horses or ponies must be 4 years or over on the day of the show.

League Rules:

- This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only and they must be a current member throughout the league.
- League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League competitions in classes that are for PC60 - PC110.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter - they get 1 point for each Class they participate in, 2 points for a double clear round and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from a maximum of 2 Classes at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule, but the results will be taken from the combination's best 2 rounds on the day.
- Points will be counted from all 6 competitions across all Classes from PC60 – PC110 resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League Champion and rosettes are from 1st to 10th place.
- Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League will take place on Sunday 2 February at the Area 13 Show Jumping Spring Festival Qualifier at BCA.

Area 13 Royal Windsor Horse Show Tickets 2025

The highest placed Pony Club member in Class 5 - PC110 will be given one of the Area 13 places to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 18 May 2025 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section of this schedule).



Rules/eligibility:

- Must be a member on date of qualifying competition AND for the Windsor date
- Must have had no more than 16 jumping faults
- RIDER can only qualify for Windsor on one horse. (If the rider wins two of the competitions on different horses, they select which one they want to take to Windsor. The Windsor qualification passes down to the next rider at that competition assuming they meet the eligibility requirements.
- Branches with members qualified through the competitions will not be able to put other names into the main draw but may put other names into the reserve draw.
- Riders who have represented Area13 at Windsor Show Jumping on TWO or more previous occasions will not be eligible to qualify this year.
