- 1. This event will be run under the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025 & Pony Club Dressage Rules 2025.
- 2. Pony Club Members may only wear spurs if they have attained C+ Test OR the NEW Spurs Test
- 3. Any horse or pony may only be ridden once in any class and in no more than **four** classes.
- 4. Objections to be made before the start of the next class, IN WRITING, accompanied by a deposit of £20. returnable if the objection is sustained.
- 5. Tack must be in safe condition. Hats conforming to current Pony Club Rules 2025 must be worn at all times when mounted. Hats must be tagged with the PINK tag. Pony Club Dress Rules apply.
- Body Protectors (if worn), must comply with BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label) is the only acceptable safety standard.
- 7. The judges' decision is final in all matters. The committee reserves the right to cancel, add or to amend any of the conditions or competitions as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion.
- 8. No lorries or trailers to be mucked out in the car park. All rubbish to be taken home. Please **remove all your droppings and hay** from the car park.
- 9. No entry will be refunded after the closing date without a doctor's or vet's certificate, to be received within 3 days of the competition.
- 10. Entries will not be accepted by telephone.
- 11. Parking is limited; please park where instructed by the stewards.
- **12.** In the event of cancellation or abandonment a £5 administration charge will be made.
