Take 1st exit on the next roundabout, then turn right onto Chertsey Road A319.

Bear left onto Old Chertsey Road. The field is about a mile on the left.

From M25, Junction 11, take the A320 signposted Woking.

At roundabout turn left A320 to Woking, At next roundabout turn right onto A319 and IMMEDIATELY right onto Foxhills road.

At the T-junction turn left onto Stonehill Road. The Field is on the right-hand side approximately 2 miles.

- <u>All ponies must be vaccinated as per Pony club rules</u>, Spot checks of passports will take place.

Staying over on the Saturday night

Competitors are welcomed to stay over at our field on Saturday eve. £10 per pony please include this when entering.

We will be running a very tight schedule so please arrive well before your time.

Competitors can arrive from 3pm on Saturday 5th April.

All ponies need to have head collars left on when penned.

The field gate must always be closed.

No x-country jumps to be jumped at any time and no hacking around the other fields of the property. The woods are out of Bounds, as is the River and Bridges.

No riding without hats at any time or bareback or in headcollars.

Dogs to be kept on leads and all mess cleared up after them.

All penned areas cleared of hay and mucked and put in the marked location. Please bring wheelbarrows.

There will be a water supply for the ponies but NOT human (please bring your own)

There will be a caterer, Sunday only- times will be confirmed

There are no 'hook up' facilities and no main flood lighting.

The Club field is on sand/loam soil and drains incredibly well. It is used all through the winter and lorries park well on it even if very wet. In the event of cancelling a decision will be made on the morning of 5th April.

There is plenty of space to pen and park but depending on the weather you might not be able to be immediately next to your ponies. No equipment for penning is provided

There will be toilets (no lights) and NO showers
