Competitors may walk the course between 2pm – 6pm on Saturday 26th April

The competition will be run under P.C. Eventing Rules 2025. It is the responsibility of competitors and their supporters to comply with the Rules.

There will be a one-off fee of £5 per rider to cover medical provision.

Class 1. 70cm INDIVIDUAL ONE DAY EVENT

ROSETTES TO 8TH PLACE

Entry fee: £60

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Dressage Test: PC 70 Test 2022

Tests may be read. To be ridden in a snaffle, no bit rings, gloves must be worn. Whips are allowed.
- Jumping height 70cm max XC, 2 fences in the SJ may be 75cm. The two jumping phases will have separate times. Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day. Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk. No stop watches.

Class 2. Dressage only competition

- Tests may be read. To be ridden in a snaffle, no bit rings, gloves must be worn. Whips are allowed.

No horse may be entered in more than one jumping class. No competitor may enter more than two horses. There will be a one-off fee of £5 per rider to cover medical provision.

Class 3. 60cm INDIVIDUAL EVENTERS' CHALLENGE WITH DRESSAGE

ROSETTES TO 8TH PLACE

Entry fee: £45

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Dressage Test: PC Introduction to Dressage Test 2019.

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.
- Show Jumping height 60cm max, and then straight onto XC phase. Max 20 jumping efforts. Penalties will be as laid down in the PC Eventing Rulebook 2025 Section C Arena Eventing.
Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day. Anyone eliminated must leave the course at walk.

Class 4 Dressage only competition

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.

No horse may be entered in more than one jumping class. No competitor may enter more than two horses. There will be a one-off fee of £5 per rider to cover medical provision.

Class 5. 50cm INDIVIDUAL EVENTERS' CHALLENGE WITH DRESSAGE ROSETTES TO 8TH PLACE

Entry fee: £45

- Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.
- Dressage Test: Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit will be allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.
- Show Jumping height 50cm max. From SJ riders will go straight onto XC phase. Maximum 20 jumping efforts. Penalties will be as laid down in the PC Eventing Rulebook 2025 Section C Arena Eventing.
- Fall of horse or rider at any stage of the competition will incur elimination. Any rider who incurs a fall must be seen by the medical personnel on the day.

Class 6 Dressage only competition

- Dressage Test: Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022

- At this competition the test may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, no bit rings. Whips are allowed.

Class 7 Dressage only competition for inexperienced competitors who just want to have a go!

Entry Fee: £20

- Dressage Test: Walk & Trot Dressage Test 2022

- **In this class the test may be read or led!** Any normal riding bit is allowed. There will not be any placings but every competitor will receive a Highly Commended rosette.

There will also be clear round SJ that will run at the end of the day with Class 7, starting with poles on the ground, giving inexperienced competitors a chance to ride in both a dressage test as well as a bit of fun jumping. Entries on the day.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Correct riding attire in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Rules 2025 must be worn when mounted. Hats must be worn to the Pony Club specifications for 2025. Cross-country colours may be worn for the jumping phase and body protectors are compulsory. The misuse of spurs, whips or any other items of tack causing discomfort to the horse may result in elimination, as will use of bad language.
- No ponies to be left tied to lorries/trailers, unattended.
- Please treat all officials with respect: they are all volunteers and have given up their day to try to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable experience.
- On the day of the competition, horses may only be ridden by the competitor in designated warm up areas and must only walk in the horsebox park. No lunging is allowed in the horsebox park, if you need to lunge, please see the Secretary for guidance regarding where to do this.
- Refunds will be given upon the production of a doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
- The judge's decision is final in all cases. Objections are to be lodged with the Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (returnable if the objection is upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident occurring.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead.
- Please do not muck out Lorries/trailers into the field, and do not leave any litter. Please remove any droppings & hay and take them home with you.

Health & Safety:

Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.

Legal Liability:

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Reasonable Adjustment:

The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by Sunday 13 April 2025.
