Important Information:

- For **SJ + XC classes**, separate SJ and XC rounds will be completed (similar to the Horse Trials, but without the dressage)
- **TEAMS**: Please indicate on entry form if you are part of a team. Teams can be made from 4 people with the best 3 scores to count, from the same class. Teams are Horse Trials classes only apart from the 40-60 where a team can be made from across sections A and B.
- **RULES**: Pony Club Eventing rules will be followed including suitable bits/tack for the dressage phase and rule and information can be found here: https://pcuk.org/eventing/
- **Dressage tests** are free to download and are available here: https://resources.pcuk.org/dressage/dressage_tests/
- **Print your own numbers from** <u>www.ponyclubresults.co.uk</u> and make **TWO** copies (1 for front of bib, 1 for back of bib). Number bibs MUST be worn for all phases.
- A **tack check** will be in operation where hats will be checked for hat tags and body protector check for a current safety label. Please check the rule for details. Hats can be tagged at the secretary if required.
- Depending on numbers, we hope to split Horse Trials sections, so please state age on entry so we can split appropriately if possible.
- Rosettes to a minimum of 6th Place in each section (placings/rosettes will increase if entries allow) and Highest Placed Wokingham Member rosettes in each section
- PLEASE TAKE ALL LITTER, HAY, AND DROPPINGS HOME WITH YOU

Classes: To start at approx 09:00am

Class 1 - PC40 - 60 SJ + XC (no dressage)

SJ and XC fences no higher than 60cm

All competitors in this class can be assisted by voice/runner or on a lead rein connected to noseband.

There is no Horse Trials section for this height. Teams can be entered in this class across both sections.

Class 2 - PC70

Dressage Test: PRELIMINARY PC70 DRESSAGE TEST 2022

SI and XC fences no higher than 70cm.

Class 3 - PC80

Dressage Test: GRASSROOTS PC80 DRESSAGE TEST 2018

SJ and XC fences no higher than 80cm.

Section A: SJ + XC (no dressage) Entry Fee: £60 Section B: Horse Trials (plus teams) Entry Fee: £80

Class 4 - PC90

Dressage Test: PC90 EVENTING TEST 2025 (note - New Test)

SJ and XC fences no higher than 90cm.

Section A: SJ + XC (no dressage)Entry Fee: £60Section B: Horse Trials (plus teams)Entry Fee: £80

Rule and Conditions of Entry:

- 1. These Horse Trials are open to all but will be run in accordance with the rules of the Pony Club Eventing 2025. If you are unsure of the correct dress for yourself and turnout of your horse or pony in any of the three phases, please check Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2025 It is the responsibility of competitors to comply with the Rules. https://resources.pcuk.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/08/2025-Rulebook-Eventing-020125.pdf
- 2. Vaccinations will be required according to Pony Club Rules 2025. It is illegal to travel your horse without its passport; spot checks may be carried out.
- 3. All riding hats must conform to Pony Club Rules 2025. Competitors may not compete without a tagged hat and must wear this at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened. A jockey skull with no fixed peak must be worn for all cross country.
- 4. Back protectors are compulsory for the cross country phase. Back protectors used for cross country must meet BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label). Air Jackets ARE NOT to be worn under any item of clothing. If worn it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector which meets the above standard.
- 5. Medical Armbands are recommended and if used MUST be worn on the arm.
- 6. Spurs: Sharp spurs are not permitted. Only blunt spurs, without rowels or sharp edges, and spurs that have a smooth rotating ball on the shank may be worn. If the spurs are curved, the curve must be downwards, and the shank must point straight to the back and not exceed 4cm in length. The measurement is taken from the boot to the end of the shank.
 - PONY CLUB MEMBERS may only wear spurs if they have passed their C+ riding and/or their Spurs Test, they must have their YELLOW spurs tag visible for checking.
- 7. Dressage phase: whips are allowed at all levels.
- 8. Dressage Tests for all classes can be found here: https://resources.pcuk.org/dressage/dressage/tests/
- 9. Electronic devices not allowed while rider is competing.
- 10. Stop watches may ONLY BE WORN IN CLASS 4
- 11. Numbers will not be given out for Number Bibs. Print your own numbers in font size 300. Bring your own number bib Numbers will be available to download from Pony Club Results
- 12. Withdrawals £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £10.00 admin fee)
- 13. In the event of cancellation prior to the event a £10.00 admin charge will be made. If the event is cancelled on the day, there will be no refund.
- 14. Horse/pony may compete in only one class.
- 15. Competitors will be required to report to stewards for all phases 15 minutes before their time. Failure to comply will carry the risk of elimination.
- 16. All stallions must wear identifying disc on their bridle written permission needed from DC/Centre Proprietor.
- 17. Competitors who are not members of The Pony Club are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Wokingham Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 18. Legal Liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone or whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 19. Reasonable Adjustment: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by Monday 28th April 2025.
