Rule and Conditions of Entry:

- 1. These Horse Trials are open to all but will be run in accordance with the rules of the Pony Club Eventing 2025. If you are unsure of the correct dress for yourself and turnout of your horse or pony in any of the three phases, please check Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2025 It is the responsibility of competitors to comply with the Rules. https://resources.pcuk.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/08/2025-Rulebook-Eventing-020125.pdf
- 2. Vaccinations will be required according to Pony Club Rules 2025. It is illegal to travel your horse without its passport; spot checks may be carried out.
- 3. All riding hats must conform to Pony Club Rules 2025. Competitors may not compete without a tagged hat and must wear this at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened. A jockey skull with no fixed peak must be worn for all cross country.
- 4. Back protectors are compulsory for the cross country. Back protectors used for cross country must meet BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label). Air Jackets ARE NOT to be worn under any item of clothing. If worn it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector which meets the above standard.
- 5. Medical Armbands are recommended and if used MUST be worn on the arm.
- 6. Spurs: Sharp spurs are not permitted. Only blunt spurs, without rowels or sharp edges, and spurs that have a smooth rotating ball on the shank may be worn. If the spurs are curved, the curve must be downwards, and the shank must point straight to the back and not exceed 4cm in length. The measurement is taken from the boot to the end of the shank.

PONY CLUB MEMBERS may only wear spurs if they have passed their C+ riding and/or their Spurs Test, they must have their YELLOW spurs tag visible for checking.

- $7.\ Electronic\ devices\ not\ allowed\ while\ rider\ is\ competing.$
- 8. Stop watches are not allowed
- 9. Numbers will not be given out for Number Bibs. Print your own numbers in font size 300. Bring your own number bib (can be purchased from CHHS on Enrymaster Numbers will be available to download from Pony Club Results 10. Withdrawals £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £10.00 admin fee)
- 11. In the event of cancellation prior to the event a £10.00 admin charge will be made. If the event is cancelled on the day, there will be no refund.
- 12. Horse/pony may compete in only two classes.
- 13. Competitors will be required to report to stewards 15 minutes before their time. Failure to comply will carry the risk of elimination.

- 14. All stallions must wear an identifying disc on their bridle written permission needed from DC.
- 15. Competitors who are not members of The Pony Club are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Wokingham Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 17. **Legal Liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone or whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 18. **Reasonable Adjustment**: The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by Monday 28th April 2025.
