TEAMS:

With the exception of Area Teams, all teams must be made up of three or four different members of the same branch or centre with best three scores to count.

If a Branch/Centre has a Member/Members who are entered as individuals at the Area Competition and not included in a Branch/Centre team, they may combine with one or more other Branch/Centre Members to form a team at the Area Competition. This team shall be eligible to qualify for the Championships. Should an Area Team qualify for the Championships, then the next placed eligible Branch/Centre Team shall also qualify. Area Teams can only be put together by the Area Representative and/or Area Organiser.

Classes 1, 3, 5, 7, 8, 12 & 16 – Rosettes to 6th place

Qualifying classes – Individuals to 8th place, Teams to 6th.

RULES and CONDITIONS of ENTRY

Your entry into a class will be deemed to be an acceptance of these Rules and Conditions of Entry. Please ensure you read them fully and carefully.

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE: The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser, officials and stewards.

LEGAL LIABILITY: Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord, his tenant(s) or his licensee accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

INSURANCE: Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by the Pony Club insurance and must have their own Third-party Liability Insurance. The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members.

REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT:

The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by 15th June 2025 to area13@pcuk.org

All persons entering the grounds shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions

1. **To be run in accordance with the Pony Club Dressage & Show Jumping Rules 2025** these can be found on the Pony Club website <https://pcuk.org/pony-club-rule-books/>. It is the responsibility of the competitors to know the rules.
2. **The judges' decisions are final**, and the Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reason.
3. Any objections must be made in writing and handed in to the show secretary with a deposit of £50. In the event of the objection being sustained the deposit will be refunded.
4. In the event of abandonment 50% of the entry fees will be refunded.
5. Withdrawals made before close of entries will be refunded less an admin fee of £5. Withdrawals made after the close of entry will not be refunded unless your place can be filled.
6. All riding hats must be tagged with the current (pink) tag. Hats must be worn at all times when competitors are mounted and the chinstrap securely fastened.
7. SPURS: Pony club members may only wear spurs if the member has passed the C+ and/or Spurs Test and you must provide proof of this to the organiser upon request. A yellow hat tag must be worn.
8. On the day of the competition, ponies may only be ridden by riders competing in the show. No lunging in the warm-up arenas or lorry park. When outside show rings and warm-up areas ponies must be ridden only at walk. Organisers reserve the right to eliminate any rider who breaks this rule or is seen to ride dangerously. **Anyone mounted must wear a hat with chinstrap fastened and their competitor number.**
9. Horses/ponies tied to the outside of trailers/lorries **MUST NOT** be left unattended.
10. **It is a condition of entry that each branch entered offers at least two people each day to help. Please sign up to help here:** volunteersignup.org/FLWJI
