Para Classes

All classes are open for Para Rider entries with rosettes for Best Placed in each class. Para riders must be medically diagnosed as having a permanent, physical impairment that can be measured objectively by a Physiotherapist or medical doctor trained in the classification system.

PLEASE READ THIS PAGE CAREFULLY RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

LEGAL LIABILITY: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event, The Pony Club, West Stoke Farm (landlord) nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of all officials and stewards.

- 1. **INSURANCE**: Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by the Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Hampshire Hunt Branch of the Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members.
- $2. \quad \text{All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.}$
- 3. This event will be run under current Pony Club Rules throughout the day. Fully comprehensive rules are available on the main Pony Club website. www.pcuk.org
- 4. <u>Cancellation/Abandonment</u>: In the event of cancellation or abandonment, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £10.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
- 5. <u>The judges' decision is final in all matters</u>. Video evidence will not be accepted in any circumstances. The show committee reserves the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the conditions or competitions as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion.
- Protests or objections must be made in writing and addressed to the Official Steward accompanied with a £20 deposit, returnable if the objection is upheld, within 30 minutes of the incident occurring or within 30 minutes of the results being announced.
- 7. <u>Refunds</u>: No entry will be refunded after the entry closing date, without the production of a Doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
- 8. <u>Hats</u>: All competitors must wear a protective Helmet manufactured to the minimum standards stated in the current Pony Club Rules. When mounted the chinstrap must be fastened at all times.
- 9. A <u>Body Protector</u>, if warn, must comply to the BETA 2018 Level 3 Standard (blue and black label) in line with the current Pony Club Rules. This is the ONLY acceptable safety standard.
- 10. <u>Air Jackets may be worn in line with the current Pony Club Rules</u>.
- 11. Pony Club Members may only wear spurs if they have attained C+ test OR the NEW Spurs Test.
- 12. <u>Reasonable Adjustment;</u> The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests must be made by **Friday 15th August**, **2025**. - 13. Horses/ponies must not be exercised near horseboxes. Please, park as instructed by the stewards.
- 14. Please ensure that your horse/pony has an up-to-date <u>vaccination certificate</u>, which is available to be checked on the day if required.
- 15. EACH HORSE/PONY MAY ONLY JUMP ONCE IN ANY CLASS & ENTER A MAXIMUM OF 3 JUMPING CLASSES.
- 16. Competitors must keep aware of ring progress to avoid conflicting/missing classes. Our Ring Steward will make every effort to accommodate clashes of classes.
- 17. All lead reins must be attached to either the noseband or a headcollar.
- 18. Horses and ponies must be over 4 years old on the day of the competition. No Stallions.
- 19. Please take all your litter home. Parking will be in a grazing paddock, please poo pick after your pony and do not muck out trailers or lorries in the parking area.

PLEASE KEEP DOGS ON SHORT LEADS AT ALL TIMES

(Do not use extending leads as these can be dangerous). Fine $\pounds 10$ for offenders

Class 1 09:30am	LEAD REIN JUMPING 30cm lead rein jumping.	
Class 2	30cm JUMPING 30cm jumping OFF the lead rein. One adult may be in the arena to encourage/support.	
Class 3 not before 10:30am	45cm JUMPING 45cm jumping OFF the lead rein. One adult may be in the arena to encourage/support.	
Class 4	45cm HORSE AND HEEL Timed rounds, one to ride, then one to run. (A class for the non-riders!)	
Class 5	PAIRS 50cm JUMPING 50cm Pairs jumping. Consecutive timed rounds	
Class 6 not before 11:30am	OPEN 60cm JUMPING 60cm Jumping with <u>separate jump off</u> .	
Class 7	CHASE-ME-CHARLIE	
Entry fees: Classes 1, 2, 3, 6 & 7: £10.00 Classes 4 & 5: £14.00 per pair.		
Classes 1, 2 & 3 will be run on a "Two Phase" basis. i.e. If competitor jumps a clear round, they do not leave the ring but will immediately continue to jump the fences in the Jump-Off section.

RING 2 **GWYNNE DENTAL Showing Ring**

Eventing Pony Exhibitors in Classes 8-10 will be judged in two phases. Competitors will be required to perform a short individual show in include walk, trot and optional canter on both reins, a freewalk on a long rein with a halt and salute to finish, as well as being judged on presentation and turnout (not including the pony's confirmation); followed by jumping a few rustic fences during which they will be judged on both style & performance.

Class 9	Studfast 45cm EVENTING PONY Judged on short individual show, turnout and to include a few rustic 45cm jumps.	
Class 10	Studfast 30cm EVENTING PONY Judged on short individual show, turnout and to include an optional 30cm jump.	
Followed by:	Studfast Eventing Pony Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 8 to 10 inclusive will be eligible for the Eventing Pony Championship Class to take place after Class 10 to award the Gwynne Dental "Champion" and "Reserve Champion" sashes.

Class 12	GWYNNE DENTAL 1 st RIDDEN Section A - 1 ^s Ridden. Riders aged 8-10 Section B - 1 ^s Ridden. Riders aged Under 8 All riders will be asked to perform a short individual show – no need to canter!
