Competitors may walk the course between 2pm – 6pm on Saturday 30th August

No pony may be entered in more than one <u>jumping</u> class. Ponies may do both the Dressage and the Show Jumping but no pony may compete in another class if it is competing in the One Day Event. No competitor may ride more than two horses. There will be a one-off fee of £5 per rider to cover medical provision.

Rosettes: Teams to 6th place, Individual rosettes to 8th place

Class 1. PC60cm INDIVIDUAL & TEAM ONE DAY EVENT

Entry fee: £60

Class 3. Show Jumping PC60 INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM COMPETITION Entry fee £28

 A two-round competition, the first not timed. The best three scores from the first round to be carried through to the second round. If a member of a team is eliminated in the first round they may still jump in the second round. In the event of team equality at the end of the second round, the team's fastest time will

Class 4. 70cm INDIVIDUAL ONE DAY EVENT

Entry fee: £50

Class 5. 50cm INDIVIDUAL ONE DAY EVENT

 Tests may be read. To be ridden in a snaffle, no bit rings, gloves must be worn. Whips are allowed.

Jumping height 50cm max XC and SJ. The two jumping phases will have separate times.

There will also be clear round SJ that will run towards the end of the day, starting with poles on the ground, giving inexperienced competitors a chance to ride a bit of fun jumping. Entries on the day.

In case of adverse weather, a notice will be posted on our website, Area 13 FB page and www.ponyclubresults.co.uk In the event of cancellation prior to the event a £10.00 admin charge will be charged.

The competition will be run under P.C. Eventing Rules 2025. It is the responsibility of competitors and their supporters to comply with the Rules.

You must provide your own number bib and numbers – these can be printed by clicking your name on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk.

- No ponies to be left tied to lorries/trailers, unattended.
- Please treat all officials with respect: they are all volunteers and have given up their day to try to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable experience.
- On the day of the competition, horses may only be ridden by the competitor in designated warm up areas and must only walk in the horsebox park. No lunging is allowed in the horsebox park, if you need to lunge, please see the Secretary for guidance regarding where to do this.
- Refunds will be given upon the production of a doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
- The judge's decision is final in all cases. Objections are to be lodged with the Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (returnable if the objection is upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident occurring.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead.
- Please do not muck out Lorries/trailers into the field, and do not leave any litter. Please remove any droppings & hay and take them home with you.

Health & Safety:

Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
