LEAGUE RULES:

- ➤ This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only and you must be a current member throughout the League.
- ➤ League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Showjumping League competitions in classes that are for PC60 PC110.
- ➤ Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in, 1 point for a double clear round and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- ➤ Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule, but the results will be taken from the combination's best 2 rounds on the day.
- ➤ Points will be counted from all 7 competitions across all Classes from PC60 PC110 resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League Champion and rosettes are from 1st to 10th place.
- ➤ New for 2025/26 will also be an Area 13 "Top of the Heights" Winners a winner rosette will be given to the person who does the best at each of the 6 competition levels.
- ➤ Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League will take place on 1 February 2026 at the Spring Festival Qualifier at BCA.

Prizes to include:

- ➤ Overall League Rosettes 1st 10th place, Sash for Winner and prizes for at least 1st 3rd place
- ➤ Top of the Heights Winner Rosette for 1st Place and prizes



Area 13 Royal Windsor Horse Show Tickets 2026

The top 6 members in the PC110 League will be given one of the Area 13 places to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 17 May 2026 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section of this schedule).

Rules/eligibility:

- ➤ Must be a member on date of competition AND for the Windsor date.
- ➤ Must have had no more than 16 jumping faults at any of the league competitions.
- ➤ RIDER can only qualify for Windsor on one horse. If the rider is placed in the top 6 of the League on more than one horse, they select which one they want to take to Windsor. The Windsor qualification passes down to the next combination in the League assuming they meet the eligibility requirements.
- ➤ Reserves will be the next placed combinations from the League competitors providing they fulfil the criteria set out in these rules.
- ➤ Riders who have represented Area 13 at Windsor Show Jumping on TWO or more previous occasions will not be eligible to qualify for the current year.

LEAGUE RULES:

- This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only.
- ➤ League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Dressage League competitions.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- N.B. In Classes 1 and 2, Section B will not count towards Winter Dressage League Points.
- ➤ Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule.
- ➤ Points will be counted from all 7 competitions across all Classes resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Dressage League Champion and rosettes are down to 10th places.
- New for 2025/26 will also be an Area 13 "Top of the Tests" Winners a winner rosette will be given to the person who does the best at each of the 6 competition levels.
- ➤ Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Dressage League will take place on Sunday 22 February at the Petersfield PC competition at Priory Equestrian Centre.

Prizes to include:

- ➤ Overall League Rosettes 1st 10th place, Sash for Winner and prizes for 1st 3rd place
- ➤ Top of the Tests Winner Rosette for 1st place and prizes

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Telephone entries or entries without the appropriate fee will not be accepted.
- 2. In the event of cancellation £4.00 per entry will be retained to cover administration costs.
- 3. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the classes they think fit, alter advertised times or refuse entry without stating reason.
- 4. All classes will be judged in accordance with the Pony Club Rules.
- 5. The judge's decision is final.
- 6. Horses/ponies must compete in the order as times given.
- 7. No horse/pony under the age of 4 may compete.
- 8. Only Pony Club approved hats to be worn.
- 9. Spurs may only be worn if you have passed your C+ and/or Spurs Test and you must provide proof of this to the organiser upon request. A yellow hat tag must be worn.
- 10. Objections accompanied by a deposit of 10.00 must be made in writing to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
- 11. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and are not allowed in the schools or gallery.
- 12. No entry fee will be refunded without a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
- 13. Please avoid Warnham Village and Mayes Lane and follow the road signs on the A24 and A29 to "Equestrian Centre". The entrance to the showground is on Three Stiles Road.

Please remove all litter and droppings from the car park before you leave

Health & Safety:
