Ages as at 1 January 2026

All shooters must be aged 8 or above on day of competition and signed off as competent to shoot

CLASS 1 – OPEN BOYS TRIATHLON – 25 years and under (Qualifier)

Shoot: turning targets with 1 hand 10 metres. Swim: 4 mins Run: 3000 metres

CLASS 2 – OPEN GIRLS TRIATHLON - 25 years and under.(Qualifier)

Shoot: turning targets with 1 hand from 10 metres Swim: 3 mins; Run: 1500 metres

CLASS 3 – JUNIOR BOYS TRIATHLON - 14 years and under (Qualifier)

Shoot: turning targets with 1 hand from 7 metres Swim: 3 minutes Run: 1500 metres

CLASS 4 – JUNIOR GIRLS TRIATHLON - 14 years and under (Qualifier)

Shoot: turning targets with 1 hand from 7 metres Swim: 3 minutes Run: 1500 metres

CLASS 5 - MINIMUS BOYS TRIATHLON - 11 years and under (Qualifier)

Shoot: turning targets with 2 hands from 7 metres Swim: 2 minutes Run: 1000 metres

CLASS 6 - MINIMUS GIRLS TRIATHLON - 11 years and under (Qualifier)

Shoot: turning targets with two hands from 7 metres Swim: 2 minutes Run: 1000 metres

CLASS 7 – TADPOLES BOYS TRIATHLON – 9 years and under

Shoot: static targets with 2 hands from 7 metres, swim 2 minutes, run 1000 metres

CLASS 8 – TADPOLES GIRLS TRIATHLON - 9 years and under

Shoot: static targets with 2 hands from 7 metres, swim 2 minutes, run 1000 metres

CLASS 9 - BEANIES BOYS TRIATHLON -7 years and under.

Bean bag throwing Swim: 2min (floatation aids allowed) Run: 500 metres

CLASS 10 - BEANIES GIRLS TRIATHLON -7 years and under.

Bean bag throwing Swim: 2min (floatation aids allowed) Run: 500 metres

Entries are invited from individuals and teams. Competitors must be members of the Pony Club. In any team the score is the sum of the best three performances overall. Teams will be created by the organisers where appropriate and a mixed-branch team may be placed above a full branch team in the final scoring.

ROSETTES for teams and individuals (Boys and Girls) to 6th Place.
Rosettes for individual phase winners.
Best South Berks in each class.

RULES

- All classes will be judged in accordance with the Pony Club Tetrathlon Rule Book 2025
- Any complaints/queries to be made by team managers only, to official organisers only, within 10 minutes of the scores being published and with a £10.00 deposit, which will be refunded if complaint is upheld.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter or combine any classes without prior notice if they feel that this is necessary.
