CLASSES:

- Class 1 Mini Section Ages to be 10 years and under on the 1st of January of competition year.
- Class 2 Junior/Senior Section- must have at least one member who is 14 years or under and then two of any age up to 25.

Teams to consist of 3 members.

If you have members who would like to have a go but don't have a full team, let us know and we will make mixed teams up from individual members.

All ages will be taken from the 1st of January of the competition year.

QUESTIONS:

The competition will consist of 6 rounds: 3 using the Quiz format and 3 using the Horse & Pony Care format.

- Mini questions to be based on the Care sections of the E, D and D+ Tests and Mini Horsemanship Achievement Badges.
- Junior/Senior questions to be based on the Care sections of the D+, C, C+ and B Tests and Achievement badges.
- Questions will be based on the new syllabuses.
- Format of questions will be a mixture of activity rounds such as puzzles, multiple choice, identification, and observation, and practical tasks in the stables and yard.
- Teams will move around the venue; each round will be on a different topic.

Entry fee: £12 per person. Entries close on Monday 15th December 2025. Withdrawals may be made without penalty up to the closing date, no refunds will be made after this date.

Competitors should dress in an appropriate manner suitable for representing their Branch or Centre:

- Pony Club sweatshirt/polo shirt/jacket.
- Jodhpurs/ breeches of any plain neutral colour, and suitable footwear for being at a stable yard.
- All competitors must wear PC tagged riding hats when handling horses, and gloves where appropriate.
- Festive additions to your clothing are very much encouraged but MUST be safe to be worn around the stable yard and horses/ ponies.
