CLASS 1	PC50cm in 1st phase. Riders may be assisted in this class, but Leading Rein will not be accepted. 12 yrs & under. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 70cm or above. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £20.00
CLASS 2	PC60cm in 1st phase. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 80cm or above. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £20.00
CLASS 3	PC70cm in 1st phase. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 90cm or above. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £20.00
CLASS 4	PC80 cm in 1st phase. Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £20.00
CLASS 5	PC90cm in 1st phase Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £20.00
CLASS 6	PC100cm in 1st phase. Single Phase Entry fee £20.00
CLASS 7	PC110cm in 1st phase. Single Phase Single phase. ENTRY FEE £20.00

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: PLEASE READ

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

No rider numbers will be issued at the venue, you will need to provide your own bridle number or bib number.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR HAT (AND BODY PROTECTOR, IF BEING WORN) ARE CORRECTLY TAGGED. BODY PROTECTORS MUST HAVE THE BLUE 2018 BETA SAFETY LABEL. If YOU ARE WEARING SPURS YOU MUST HAVE A YELLOW HAT TAG.

Ponies / horses must not be left tied to the outside of horse boxes/trailers at any time. No dogs allowed at the venue.

- Health, Safety and Welfare: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025. Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced, including spur and whip rules. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules. Please refer to the main Pony Club website for a downloadable copy of the rule book.
- The judge's decision is **final**. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 no later than 20 minutes after the incident.

- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- Entry fees will only be refunded at the discretion of the organisers and on production of a valid vet's or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition. In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the B&SC website. Monies will be refunded less £5.00 per entry administration fee.
- No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.

The Bisley & Sandown Chase Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.

Area 13 Royal Windsor Horse Show Tickets 2026



The top 6 members in the PC110 League will be given one of the Area 13 places to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 17 May 2026 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section of this schedule).

Rules/eligibility:

- Must be a member on date of competition AND for the Windsor date
- Must have had no more than 16 jumping faults at any of the league competitions
- RIDER can only qualify for Windsor on one horse. If the rider is placed in the top 6 of the league on more than one horse, they select which one they want to take to Windsor. The Windsor qualification passes down to the next combination in the league assuming they meet the eligibility requirements.
- Reserves will be the next placed combinations from the League competitors providing they fulfil the criteria set out in these rules.
- Riders who have represented Area13 at Windsor Show Jumping on TWO or more previous occasions will not be eligible to qualify for the current year.
