Teams may be made up including competitors from Section B but these will not be able to qualify for the Spring Festival Finals.

- Class 5: PC Intermediate Dressage Test 2024
- Class 6: PC Open Dressage Test 2020

#### **LEAGUE RULES:**

- ➤ This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only.
- > League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Dressage League competitions.
- ➤ Combinations can earn points in each Class entered they get 1 point for each Class they participate in and earn additional points if they are placed within 1- combinations, i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all classes.
- **▶** N.B. In Classes 1 and 2, Section B will not count towards Winter Dressage League Points.
- ➤ Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule.
- > Points will be counted from all 7 competitions across all Classes resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Dressage League Champion and rosettes are down to 10th places.
- ➤ New for 2025/26 will also be an Area 13 "Top of the Tests" Winners a winner rosette will be given to the person who does the best at each of the 6 competition levels.
- > Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Dressage League will take place on Sunday 22 February at the Petersfield PC competition at Priory Equestrian Centre.

#### Prizes to include:

- > Overall League Rosettes 1st 10th place, Sash for Winner and prizes for 1st 3rd place
- ➤ Top of the Tests Winner Rosette for 1st place and prizes

#### IMPORTANT NOTE RE PARKING

Parking on the day will be limited, please obey the parking stewards at all times; they will advise where to park.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.

- ➤ In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £5.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
- Any objection should be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £25.00. After due consideration of the objection, the Judge or Chief Steward's decision is final.
- ➤ Withdrawals £5.00 admin fee per class will be deducted from any refunds made before the closing date. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event. (less £5.00 admin fee).
- **No lungeing** on show ground.
- > Dogs must be on leads at all times.

**Legal Liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

**Health and Safety**: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
