Important Information

Classes

1, 2, 3, 4 & 5

ENTRY FEE - £23.00 - Area Competitions and the Championships Spring Festival Area will run in accordance with the current Pony Club Show Jumping Rule Book and The

Pony Club Spring Festival 2026 Rules. Due to the daylight restrictions at this time of year, this class will be run as single phase rather than table A7. Class faults are accumulated in both sections with all riders going through to the timed part of the course against the clock.

First Aid

First Aid - £3.00 - All riders are subject to this fee.

Placings

All Classes – Individuals - Rosettes from 1st to 8th place with Sashes for Class Winners.

All Classes - Teams - Rosettes from 1st to 6th Place with Sashes for Winning Team.

This competition is the final for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League. Prizegiving will take place here at the end of the day for the overall Winners and the Top of Heights Winners.

The Qualifying Class competition comprises:

The individual competition – the scores for all competitors in the competition automatically count for this competition. It is also open to all competitors in the team competition (below).

The team competition – open to teams that must consist of three members from each Branch/Centre with all three scores to count.

Spring Festival Qualifier Rules and Qualifications:

Competitors are responsible for checking that both the rider and their horses are eligible to compete in these classes. See the <u>Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Rules</u>.

In all classes, 1-4th place will qualify for the Championships if there are up to 50 entries and then on a ratio basis of 1 additional qualifying place per 10 additional entries. In Class 6 the top 4 places will qualify for the Championships. This will increase by 1 additional qualifying place if there are more than 15 starters.

The winning team of 3 at each level at the Area competition will also qualify the championships.

Prize giving for each class will be done approx 15-20 mins after the class ends.

IMPORTANT INFORMTION ON THE DAY

- **Numbers**: No numbers will be issued at the venue. Please use your own bridle or numnah numbers.
- ➤ **Hats & Passports** Riders to declare on the day with their passports and hats. Passports will be checked on the day. All hats to have been tagged with the Pink hat tags prior to arriving at the competition.
- > **Spurs** anyone wanting to ride in spurs must have the PC approved tag on their hat. No tag, no spurs.
- **Warm up** Numbers in the Warm up will be limited and managed by the Warm Up steward on the day.
- **Prizegiving** Competitors are expected to be correctly dressed for prizegiving.
- ➤ **Lorry Park** No horses/ponies to be left unattended outside of horse boxes/trailer. All droppings/dropped hay and rubbish to be picked up and taken home.
- **Dogs** All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

- 1. **Health & Safety -** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- 2. **Legal Liability** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 3. **Insurance**: Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Wokingham Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 4. **Reasonable Adjustments:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that wherever possible members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made at least **7 days before the day of the competition**. Details of the Pony Club Reasonable Adjustment Policy can be found here:

- 5. **Rule Books** This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026 and the **Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Rules** with the exception of the new Spur Rule, which is already current. Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced, including spur and whip rules. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules.
- 6. **Objections** The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 not later than 20 minutes after the incident.
- 7. **Refusal of Entries** The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- 8. **Refunds** Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition.
- 9. **Event Cancellation** In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the Wokingham PC website and Pony Club Results. Monies will be refunded less £7.50 per entry administration fee.
- 10. **Horses** No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition. Horses or ponies must be 4 years or over on the day of the show.

LEAGUE RULES:

- This League is for Area 13 Pony Club Members only and you must be a current member throughout the league.
- ➤ League entry is automatic if you enter for any of the eligible Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League competitions in classes that are for PC60 PC110.
- Combinations can earn points in each Class that they enter they get 1 point for each Class they participate in, 1 point for a double clear round and earn additional points if they are in the top 10 combinations i.e. 10 points for 1st place, going down to 1 point for 10th place across all the classes.
- Results for each Combination will be counted from 2 Classes only at each show. Note: Combinations may compete at more levels if they meet the eligibility criteria on the specific schedule, but the results will be taken from the combination's best 2 rounds on the day.
- Points will be counted from all 7 competitions across all Classes from PC60 PC110 resulting in one overall Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League Champion and rosettes are from 1st to 10th place.
- New for 2025/26 will also be an Area 13 "Top of the Heights" Winners a winner rosette will be given to the person who does the best at each of the 6 competition levels.
- > Prize Giving for the Area 13 Winter Show Jumping League will take place on 1 February 2026 at the Spring Festival Qualifier at BCA.

Area 13 Royal Windsor Horse Show Tickets 2026

The top 6 members in the PC110 League will be given one of the Area 13 places to ride at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in the Pony Club 110 Show Jumping competition Sunday 17 May 2026 (subject to the conditions outlined in the rules section of this schedule).



Rules/eligibility:

- Must be a member on date of competition AND for the Windsor date.
- Must have had no more than 16 jumping faults at any of the League competitions.
- > RIDER can only qualify for Windsor on one horse. If the rider is placed in the top 6 of the League on more than one horse, they select which one they want to take to Windsor. The Windsor qualification passes down to the next combination in the league assuming they meet the eligibility requirements.
- Reserves will be the next placed combinations from the League competitors providing they fulfil the criteria set out in these rules.
- Riders who have represented Area 13 at Windsor Show Jumping on TWO or more previous occasions will not be eligible to qualify this year.
