- Age as per Rule Book

- Entry fee: £100.00

CLASS 3: PAIRS | Members must have attained their 11th birthday before the beginning of the current calendar year and must not have reached their 19th birthday by the same date

- Age as per Rule Book
- Games as per Rule Book 2026
- Entry fee: £50.00 per pairs

1. Withdrawals before close of entries will get a full refund less a £10.00 admin fee. No refunds will be made after the closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within one week of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event.
2. Should the Show be cancelled the organisers reserve the right to withhold £10.00 of each entry fee to offset costs.

7. **Insurance:** All non-members competing at a Pony Club organised event, should have their own Third-Party Liability Insurance.


