ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday 13th April (or when classes are full).

Late entries will be charged an additional fee of £10 for the ODE, and £5 for Dressage or SJ classes.

Competitors may walk the jumping courses between 2pm – 6pm on Saturday 25th April

In the event of adverse weather, a notice will be posted on our website, Area 13 FB page and www.ponyclubresults.co.uk In the event of cancellation prior to the event a £10.00 admin charge will be made. Look out for community WhatsApp group to be created nearer the time.

Times will be published on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk by 6pm on Thursday 23rd April.

The competition will run under P.C. Rules 2026. It is the responsibility of competitors and their supporters to comply with the Rules, which can be downloaded from the PCUK website.

No pony may be entered in more than one jumping class. No competitor may enter more than two horses. There will be a one-off fee of £5 per rider to cover medical provision.

Class 1. PC50cm INDIVIDUAL ONE DAY EVENT (Dressage, SJ and XC. Times for each phase will be allocated and published on ponyclubresults before the event.)

Individual class prizes may be split by age if appropriate.

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit will be allowed, no bit rings or boots on the pony.
- Show Jumping height 50cm max.
- XC height 50cm max.
- **NOTE: ASSISTANCE IS PERMITTED IN THIS CLASS – BUT NO LEADING OR HOLDING REINS**

Class 2. PC60cm INDIVIDUAL ONE DAY EVENT (Dressage, SJ and XC. Times for each phase will be allocated and published on ponyclubresults before the event.)

Tests may be read. Any normal riding bit is allowed, as is discreet use of the voice. No bit rings or boots on the pony.
- Show Jumping height 60cm max.
- XC phase height 60cm max.

Class 3. PC70cm INDIVIDUAL ONE DAY EVENT (Dressage, SJ and XC. Times for each phase will be allocated and published on ponyclubresults before the event.)

Tests may be read. To be ridden in any normal riding bit and discreet use of the voice is allowed. No bit rings or boots on the pony, gloves must be worn.

- XC phase jumping height 70cm max. No stop watches.

Tests may be read. To be ridden in any normal riding bit, and discreet use of the voice is allowed, but no bit rings or boots on the pony, gloves must be worn.

Tests may be read and discreet use of the voice is allowed. To be ridden in a snaffle bit. No bit rings or boots on the pony, gloves must be worn.

Class 7. PC80 Show Jumping

Entry fee: £20 Jumping height 80cm. Single phase.

Class 8. Dressage only for inexperienced competitors who just want to have a go!

Entry Fee: £20

Tests may be read. Ponies may be led. Any normal riding bit will be allowed.

There will not be any placings but every competitor will receive a Highly Commended rosette.

There will also be clear round SJ which will run at the end of the day, starting with poles on the ground, giving inexperienced competitors a chance to ride.

Cash entries for the jumping on the day. £6 for one round, £10 for two.

No pony may jump more than three times.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Correct riding attire in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Rules 2026 must be worn when mounted. Hats must be worn to the Pony Club specifications. Cross-country colours may be worn for the xc jumping phase and body protectors are compulsory.
- No ponies to be left tied to lorries/trailers unattended.
- Please treat all officials with respect: they are all volunteers and have given up their day to try to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable experience.
- On the day of the competition, horses may only be ridden by the competitor in designated warm up areas and must only walk in the horsebox park. No lunging is allowed in the horsebox park, if you need to lunge, please see the Secretary for guidance regarding where to do this.
- Refunds will only be given upon the production of a doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
- The judge's decision is final in all cases. Objections are to be lodged with the Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (returnable if the objection is upheld) within 30 minutes of the incident occurring.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
- Please do not muck out Lorries/trailers into the field, and do not leave any litter. Please remove any droppings & hay and take them home with you.

Health & Safety:

Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.

Legal Liability:

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Reasonable Adjustment:

The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made **by Sunday 11th April 2026**.
