## RING 1

### PC70, PC70 PAIRS, PC80, PC90, PC100

#### **CLASS 1 MILLBOURN ROSS PC70 Team and Individual Jumping** ☀️

Jumps approx 70cm – 75cm.

Class will be a single phase open to individuals and teams.

Combination not to have competed at 90cm and above



#### **CLASS 2 PC70 PAIRS Jumping** ☀️

Jumps approx 70cm – 75cm.

Class will be a single phase open to pairs only.

Combination not to have competed at 90cm and above

#### **CLASS 3 SEAFORD COLLEGE PC80 Individual and Team Jumping** ☀️

Jumps approx 80 – 85cm.

Class will be a single phase open to individuals and teams.

Combination not to have competed at 1m and above.



#### **CLASS 4 MOORE BARLOW PC90 Individual and Team Jumping** ☀️

Jumps approx. 90-95cm.

Class will be a single phase open to individuals and teams.

Combination not to have competed at 1.10m and above.



#### **CLASS 5 PC100 Individual and Team Jumping** ☀️

Jumps approx. 1m - 1.05m.

Class will be a single phase open to individuals and teams.

Combination not to have competed at 1.20m and above.

## RING 2

### 40CM, 50CM, 50CM PAIRS, 60CM, 60CM PAIRS



#### **CLASS 6 CHICHESTER VETS 40cm Team and Individual Jumping**

40-45cms with x poles.

12 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026

Class will be a single phase open to individuals and teams.

Section A – Lead Rein only

Section B – Off Lead Rein

Please enter in the spirit of the class and enter the appropriate section.

#### **CLASS 7 50cm Team and Individual Jumping**

Jumps 50-55cm.

13 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026

Class will be a single phase open to individuals and teams.

Combination not to have competed at 70cm and above

#### **CLASS 8 50cm Pairs Jumping**

Jumps 50-55cm.

13 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026

Class will be a single phase open to pairs only.

Combination not to have competed at 70cm and above

#### **CLASS 9 60cm Team and Individual Jumping**

Jumps 60 - 65cm.

13 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026

Class will be a single phase open to individuals and teams.

Combination not to have competed at 80cm and above

#### **CLASS 10 60cm Pairs Jumping**

Jumps 60 - 65cm.

13 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026

Class will be a single phase open to pairs only.

Combination not to have competed at 80cm and above

#### **All classes will run as SINGLE PHASE**

Approx 12 fences in total with faults accrued throughout. All riders will jump the full course, even with faults in the first half, unless eliminated.

The second section of the course will be timed. Winner is the rider with the fewest (or zero) total faults with the fastest time in the second section.

Teams will have the best 3 scores added together

## RING 3

### CLEAR ROUND JUMPING

£5 PER ROUND, ENTRY ON THE DAY

#### COWDRAY TEAM SHOW JUMPING CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRY FEE - £18 for non-pony club/ £16 for Pony Club members, per individual per class

- **Entry made as individuals, if you want to compete as a team/pair please confirm your team name with your branch team manager and enter your team name on your entry form**
- Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 riders who are members of the same branch of the Pony Club where applicable and the best three scores will count.
- Competitors may compete at more than one level but any combination of rider/pony to jump at adjacent heights. i.e. 40cm and 50cm, not 40cm and 60cm.
- Horse/pony may be ridden by two competitors but at different levels and any pony must not be entered in more than three jumping rounds.

#### ROSETTES

Rosettes will be awarded as follows:

- Team rosettes placings 1st - 6th
- Individual rosettes placings 1st - 8th
- Pairs classes, rosettes awarded to pairs 1st -4th

## Rules and Conditions of Entry

**Your entry into a class will be deemed to be an acceptance of these Rules and Conditions of Entry. Please ensure you read them fully and carefully.**

**HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE:** The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.

**Legal Liability:** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this Event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to **horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.**

1. **INSURANCE:** All non-members competing at a Pony Club organised event, should have their own Third-Party Liability Insurance.
2. **HATS:** when mounted, riders must wear hard hats conforming to the Pony Club rules for 2026. Hat and tack will be checked by the steward ahead of the class.
3. Show jumping classes run under Pony Club Rules for Show Jumping 2026. Pony Club Rules for Show Jumping are available on the Pony Club Website

4. **SPURS:** Pony club members may only wear spurs if the member has passed C+ Test and/or Spurs Test and you must provide proof of this to the organiser upon request. A yellow hat tag must be worn.
5. Horses/Ponies must NOT be left unattended when tied up to lorries/trailers.
6. On the day of the competition, ponies may only be ridden by riders competing in the show. No lunging in the warm-up arenas or lorry park. When outside show rings and warm-up areas ponies must be ridden only at walk. Organisers reserve the right to eliminate any rider who breaks this Rule or is seen to ride dangerously.
7. Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times.
8. Do not muck out your lorry / trailer onto the showground. Take your hay and muck home please.
9. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving reason, cancel or alter the classes and times.
10. Refunds will be given upon the production of a vet's or doctor's certificate within 3 days of the event.
11. Cancellation/abandonment: the Organisers reserve the right to cancel, and/or amend, any of the classes as they feel fit or alter advertised time or refuse entry without stating reason. In the event of cancellation of show, entry fees will be refunded, less £5.
12. **The organiser's decision is final in all matters.** Any objection must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the results being announced and be accompanied by a deposit of £10.
13. No entries except for Clear round will be accepted on the day.
14. Riders in lead rein classes may not compete off lead in non-lead rein classes. Lead reins to be attached to the noseband only.
15. All class times are approximate and are given as a guide only. The organisers will endeavour to keep to time but it is the responsibility of competitors to appear for classes when required.
16. Rude or offensive language or behaviour will not be tolerated. Misuse of whip, spurs or bit will be deemed offensive behaviour and the competitor will be eliminated from the whole competition.

**REASONABLE ADJUSTMENT:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible, members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by 15 May 2026.
