RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

LEGAL LIABILITY: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event, The Pony Club, West Stoke Farm (landlord) nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. **Entries are only accepted on this basis.**

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of all officials and stewards.

1. **INSURANCE:** Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are not covered by the Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Hampshire Hunt Branch of the Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members.
2. All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
3. This event will be run under current [Pony Club Rules](#) throughout the day. Fully comprehensive rules are available on the main Pony Club website. www.pcuk.org
4. **Cancellation/Abandonment:** In the event of cancellation or abandonment, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £10.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
5. **The judges' decision is final in all matters.** Video evidence will not be accepted in any circumstances. The show committee reserves the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the conditions or competitions as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion.
6. **Protests or objections** must be made in writing and addressed to the Official Steward accompanied with a £20 deposit, returnable if the objection is upheld, within 30 minutes of the incident occurring or within 30 minutes of the results being announced.
7. **Refunds:** No entry will be refunded after the entry closing date, without the production of a Doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event.
8. **Hats:** All competitors must wear a protective Helmet manufactured to the minimum standards stated in the current [Pony Club Rules Hat Rules](#). When mounted the chinstraps must be fastened at all times.
9. A **Body Protector**, if worn, must comply with the current [Pony Club Body Protector Rules](#). This is the ONLY acceptable safety standard.
10. **Air Jackets** may be worn in line with the current Pony Club Rules.
11. Pony Club Members may only wear spurs if they have attained C+ test OR the NEW Spurs Test.
12. **Reasonable Adjustment:** The Pony Club is committed to ensuring that, wherever possible members are able to access all aspects of the Branch and Centre activities we offer. Reasonable Adjustments are any actions that help to reduce the effect of a disability or difficulty. Any requests must be made by email 7 days prior to the show date. 13. Horses/ponies must not be exercised near horseboxes. Please, park where instructed by the stewards.
14. Please ensure that your horse/pony is vaccinated according to the [Pony Club Equine Influenza Rules](#) and have the relevant passport documentation available to be checked on the day if required.
15. EACH HORSE/PONY MAY ONLY JUMP ONCE IN ANY CLASS.
16. EACH HORSE/PONY MAY ENTER A MAXIMUM of 3 SHOWJUMPING CLASSES.
17. Entries will be accepted on the day, space permitting. Late entries £2.00 extra per class.
18. Competitors must keep aware of ring progress to avoid conflicting/missing classes. Every effort will be made to accommodate clashes of classes.
19. All lead reins must be attached to either the noseband or a headcollar.
20. Horses and ponies must be at least 5 years old on the day of the competition. No Stallions.
21. **Please take all your litter home. Parking will be in a grazing paddock, please poo pick after your pony and do not muck out trailers or lorries in the parking area.**

PLEASE KEEP DOGS ON SHORT LEADS AT ALL TIMES
(Do not use extending leads as these can be dangerous).

Snowfinel Show Jumping Ring

Starting: 9:00am prompt

Class 1 09:00 prompt	Snowfinel 60cm SHOW JUMPING Section A: Combination not to have been placed 1 st -3 rd in any SJ class at this height or above. Section B: Open to all. Special rosette to highest placed 9 yrs & under in both sections
Class 2	Snowfinel PC70 SHOW JUMPING Section A: Combination not to have been placed 1 st -3 rd in any SJ Class at this height or above. Section B: Open to all. Special rosette to highest placed 10 yrs & under in both sections
Class 3 Not before 10:30am.	Snowfinel PC80 SHOW JUMPING Section A: Combination not to have been placed 1 st -3 rd in any SJ class at this height or above. Section B: Open to all. Special rosette to highest placed 12 yrs & under in both sections
Class 4	Snowfinel PC90 SHOW JUMPING Section A: Pony Club Members only Section B: Open to all.
Class 5 Not before 12:00 noon.	Snowfinel 30cm SHOW JUMPING Section A: LEAD REIN JUMPING Section B: JUMPING - NOT TO BE LED One adult may be in the arena to encourage/support.
Class 6	Snowfinel 40cm SHOW JUMPING Section A: LEAD REIN JUMPING Section B: JUMPING - NOT TO BE LED One adult may be in the arena to encourage/support.
Class 7	Snowfinel 50cm SHOW JUMPING Section A: Combination not to have been placed 1 st -3 rd in any SJ class at this height or above. Section B: Open to all. Special rosette to highest placed 8 yrs & under in both sections.

Entry Fees: Classes 1 - 7: £12.00

ALL Classes will be one round of Show Jumping in a "Two Phase" format. i.e. If competitor jumps a clear round, they do not leave the ring but will immediately continue to jump the fences in the Jump-Off section. A bell will be rung if the competitor has incurred faults, and he/she will leave the ring at the end of the first phase.

RING 2

GWYNNE DENTAL Showing Ring

Starting: 9:00am prompt

For all the showing classes Competitors will be judged on Turnout of horse and rider. Ponies should be plaited for all classes, riders should have pale jodhpurs, with jacket and tie/stock.	
Eventing Horse/Pony Competitors in classes 8-11 will be judged in two phases. Competitors will be required to perform a short individual show to include walk, trot and canter on both reins, a free walk on a long rein with a halt and salute to finish plus presentation and turnout; followed by jumping a short course of rustic fences during which they will be judged on both style & performance. Confirmation of the horse/pony will NOT be judged.	
Class 8 09:00 prompt	StudFast 90cm Eventing Horse/Pony Horses and ponies of any height. To be judged on a short show followed by a course of rustic working hunter 90cm jumps.
Class 9	StudFast 80cm Eventing Horse/Pony Horses and ponies of any height. To be judged on a short show followed by a course of rustic working hunter 80cm jumps.
Class 10 Not before 10:30am.	StudFast 70cm Eventing Pony Ponies to be 147cms or under. To be judged on a short show followed by a course of rustic working hunter 70cm jumps.
Class 11	StudFast 60cm Eventing Pony Ponies to be 147cms or under. To be judged on a short show followed by a course of rustic working hunter 60cm jumps.
Followed by:	Gwynne Dental Eventing Pony Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 8 to 11 inclusive will be eligible for the Eventing Pony Championship to take place after Class 11.
Showing Competitors in classes 14-15 will be judged on a short individual show to include walk, trot and optional canter both reins, a free walk on a long rein with a halt and salute to finish, no jumping required; plus presentation & turnout.	
Class 14 Not before 12:00 noon.	Gwynne Dental Showing Horses and ponies of any height. Section A – Prettiest Mare sponsored by ZEV Section B – Most Handsome Gelding sponsored by ZEV
Class 15	Gwynne Dental Veteran Horse/Pony Ridden or In-Hand Horses and ponies of any height. Section A: Pre-Veteran (15-19 years) Section B: Veteran (20-24 years) Section C: Diamond (25 years Plus)

Tow and Farm Handy Pony Ring

Class 16	Handy Pony is a fun challenge where you and your pony negotiate an obstacle course together. The course will involve mounted and unmounted tasks (such as pushing a wheelbarrow while leading your pony & hanging washing on a line and well as negotiating bending poles while mounted and holding a cup of water) to see how unflappable and generally amazing your pony really is. Full course instructions will be given on the day. The course will be timed with a leaderboard! Rosettes to all.
